- Amend the Transportation, Housing, and Local Government Committee Report, dated May 2, 2023, page 47 of the report, strike lines 4 through 16 and substitute: "The OFFICE OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SHALL IDENTIFY POTENTIAL GRANT AND INCENTIVE RESOURCES THAT MAY SUPPORT STRATEGIC GROWTH OBJECTIVES AND STRATEGIC GROWTH AREAS;
  - (b) The office of economic development shall coordinate with the economic development commission, created in section 24-46-102, and the strategic growth committee, created in section 29-33-103, to consider the establishment of strategic growth objectives that seek to align statewide housing, transportation, and economic development goals; and
  - (c) Subsequently, the office of economic development shall submit a report to the committee of reference for review on or before December 31, 2023. At a minimum, the report must include:
  - (I) IDENTIFICATION OF GRANT AND INCENTIVE RESOURCES THAT MAY SUPPORT STRATEGIC GROWTH OBJECTIVES AND STRATEGIC GROWTH AREAS;
  - (II) RECOMMENDATIONS DEVELOPED IN COORDINATION THE STRATEGIC GROWTH COMMITTEE AND THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION THAT MAY ALIGN INCENTIVES AND RESOURCES WITH STRATEGIC GROWTH OBJECTIVES AND STRATEGIC GROWTH AREAS; AND
- 24 (III) ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITIES TO SUPPORT STRATEGIC GROWTH 25 OBJECTIVES AND STRATEGIC GROWTH AREAS ACROSS THE STATE.".
