- 15 (b) RECORDS OF COMPLAINTS IN AN EMPLOYER'S DESIGNATED
- 16 REPOSITORY MAINTAINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBSECTION (2) ARE
- 17 NOT PUBLIC RECORDS, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 24-72-202 (6), AND, FOR
- 18 PURPOSES OF AN EMPLOYER THAT IS SUBJECT TO PART 2 OF ARTICLE 72 OF
- 19 TITLE 24, RECORDS IN A DESIGNATED REPOSITORY ARE CONSIDERED
- 20 PERSONNEL RECORDS, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 24-72-202 (4.5), AND ARE
- 21 NOT OPEN TO PUBLIC INSPECTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-72-204
- 22 (3)(a)(II)(A). ADDITIONALLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 24-72-204
- 23 (3)(a)(X), ANY RECORD OF A SEXUAL HARASSMENT COMPLAINT OR
- 24 INVESTIGATION IS NOT OPEN TO PUBLIC INSPECTION EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED
- 25 IN SAID SECTION 24-72-204 (3)(a)(X).".
