- 31 (1) A RETAIL MARIJUANA ACCELERATOR TRANSPORTER LICENSE MAY BE

- "SECTION 19. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 39-28.8-202, amend (1)(a)(I) as follows:
  - **39-28.8-202. Retail marijuana sales tax.** (1) (a) (I) In addition to the tax imposed pursuant to part 1 of article 26 of this title 39 and the sales tax imposed by a local government pursuant to title 29, 30, 31, or 32, but except as otherwise set forth in subsections (1)(a)(II) and (1)(a)(III) of this section, beginning January 1, 2014, and through June 30, 2017, there is imposed upon all RETAIL sales of retail marijuana and retail marijuana products by a retailer a tax at the rate of ten percent of the amount of the sale. Beginning July 1, 2017, there is imposed upon all sales of retail marijuana and retail marijuana products by a retailer a tax at the rate of fifteen percent of the amount of the sale. The tax imposed by this section is computed in accordance with schedules or forms prescribed by the executive director of the department; except that a retail marijuana store RETAILER is not allowed to retain any portion of the retail marijuana sales tax collected pursuant to this part 2 to cover the expenses of collecting and remitting the tax. The executive director may promulgate rules to implement this section.".
