

HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Appropriations.

HB23-1294 be amended as follows:

1 Amend the Energy and Environment Committee Report, dated April 20,
2 2023, page 16, after line 24 insert:

3 **"SECTION 15. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2023-24 state fiscal
4 year, \$79,493 is appropriated to the department of public health and
5 environment for use by the air pollution control division This
6 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the division
7 may use this appropriation as follows:

8 (a) \$71,473 for personal services related to stationary sources,
9 which amount is based on an assumption that the division will require an
10 additional 0.9 FTE; and

11 (b) \$8,020 for operating expenses related to stationary sources.

12 (2) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$820,697 is appropriated to
13 the department of natural resources. This appropriation is from the oil and
14 gas conservation and environmental response fund created in section
15 34-60-122 (5), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may use this
16 appropriation as follows:

17 (a) \$725,531 for use by the oil and gas conservation commission
18 for program costs, which amount is based on an assumption that the
19 commission will require an additional 6.0 FTE; and

20 (b) \$95,166 for use by the executive director's office for the
21 purchase of legal services.

22 (3) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$95,166 is appropriated to
23 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
24 received from the department of natural resources under subsection (2)(b)
25 of this section and is based on an assumption that the department of law
26 will require an additional 0.5 FTE. To implement this act, the department
27 of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for the
28 department of natural resources.

29 (4) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$61,616 is appropriated to
30 the legislative department. This appropriation is from the general fund. To
31 implement this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:

32 (a) \$26,180 for use by the legislative council, which amount is
33 based on an assumption that the council will require an additional 0.3
34 FTE;

35 (b) \$18,452 for use by the committee on legal services, which
36 amount is based on an assumption that the committee will require an
37 additional 0.2 FTE; and

38 (c) \$16,984 for use by the general assembly."

39 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

1 Page 16 of the report, after line 30 insert:

2 "Page 1 of the bill, line 102, strike "POLLUTION." and substitute
3 "POLLUTION, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN
4 APPROPRIATION."."
