"SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 16-11.3-103.6 as follows:

16-11.3-103.6. Age of delinquency task force - created - report.

- (1) There is created in the commission the age of delinquency task force, referred to in this section as the "task force," to study and review the appropriateness of the age of prosecution in regard to offenders ten years of age or older but under thirteen years of age. The task force shall consider whether any offenses committed by children ten years of age or older but under thirteen years of age can safely and responsibly be served and rehabilitated through services and programs outside the scope of the juvenile justice system, or through revisions to the juvenile justice system, without presenting an increased threat to public safety and while respecting and providing for the constitutional and statutory rights of victims at the same level provided by current law.
- (2) THE COMMISSION SHALL APPOINT MEMBERS TO THE TASK FORCE AS IT DEEMS NECESSARY TO FURTHER THE PURPOSES OF THE TASK FORCE.
- (3) On or before January 31, 2024, the task force shall submit and present a report, including findings and recommendations concerning modification to the juvenile justice system, or alternatives to involvement in the juvenile justice system, for children ten years of age or older but under thirteen years of age to the house of representatives judiciary committee and the senate judiciary committee, or their successor committees."."."
