

## SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

BY SENATOR Fenberg

1 Amend the printed bill, page 13, line 22, strike "THREE" and substitute  
2 "FIVE".

3 Page 48, line 8, strike "THREE" and substitute "FIVE".

4 Page 79, line 26, after "44." insert "NOTHING IN THIS SECTION PRECLUDES  
5 REMUNERATION FOR BONA FIDE HARM REDUCTION SERVICES OR BONA FIDE  
6 SUPPORT SERVICES USED CONCURRENTLY WITH THE SHARING OF NATURAL  
7 MEDICINE OR NATURAL MEDICINE PRODUCT, PROVIDED THAT THERE IS NO  
8 ADVERTISEMENT RELATED TO THE SHARING OF NATURAL MEDICINE,  
9 NATURAL MEDICINE PRODUCT, OR THE SERVICES PROVIDED.".

10 Page 82, before line 1 insert:

11 "SECTION 33. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 19-2.5-103, **amend**  
12 (1)(a)(I) and (5) as follows:

13 **19-2.5-103. Jurisdiction.** (1) Except as otherwise provided by  
14 law, the juvenile court has exclusive original jurisdiction in proceedings:

15 (a) Concerning any juvenile ten years of age or older who has  
16 violated:

17 (I) Any federal or state law, except nonfelony state traffic, game  
18 and fish, and parks and recreation laws or rules; the offense specified in  
19 section 18-13-122, concerning the illegal possession or consumption of  
20 ethyl alcohol or marijuana by an underage person or illegal possession of  
21 marijuana paraphernalia by an underage person; the offenses specified in  
22 section 18-18-406 (5)(b)(I) and (5)(b)(II), concerning marijuana and  
23 marijuana concentrate; THE OFFENSES SPECIFIED IN SECTION 18-18-434  
24 CONCERNING NATURAL MEDICINE AND NATURAL MEDICINE PRODUCT; and  
25 the civil infraction in section 18-7-109 (3), concerning exchange of a  
26 private image by a juvenile;

27 (5) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section to the  
28 contrary, the juvenile court and the county court have concurrent  
29 jurisdiction over a juvenile who is under eighteen years of age and who  
30 is charged with a violation of section 18-13-122, 18-18-406 (5)(b)(I) and  
31 (5)(b)(II), 18-18-428, 18-18-429, 18-18-430, ~~18-18-434~~, or 42-4-1301;  
32 except that, if the juvenile court accepts jurisdiction over such a juvenile,  
33 the county court jurisdiction terminates.".
