Second Reading

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 14, strike lines 2 through 15 and substitute:

2 "SECTION 6. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 34-60-106, **add**
3 (11)(d) as follows:

4 **34-60-106. Additional powers of commission - rules -**
5 **definitions - repeal.** (11) (d) (I) BY APRIL 28, 2024, THE COMMISSION
6 SHALL PROMULGATE RULES THAT EVALUATE AND ADDRESS THE
7 CUMULATIVE IMPACTS OF OIL AND GAS OPERATIONS. THE RULES SHALL
8 INCLUDE A DEFINITION OF CUMULATIVE IMPACTS.

9 (II) THE COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE RESOURCES TO SUPPORT
10 COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT IN THE PROCESS FROM AFFECTED
11 COMMUNITIES, INCLUDING TRANSLATION, OUTREACH, AND OTHER
12 STRATEGIES TO SUPPORT PUBLIC PARTICIPATION.

13 (III) IN PROMULGATING THE DEFINITION OF CUMULATIVE IMPACTS
14 BY RULE PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (11)(d)(I) OF THIS SECTION, THE
15 COMMISSION SHALL REVIEW, CONSIDER, AND INCLUDE ADDRESSABLE
16 IMPACTS TO CLIMATE, PUBLIC HEALTH, THE ENVIRONMENT, AIR QUALITY,
17 WATER QUALITY, NOISE, ODOR, WILDLIFE, AND BIOLOGICAL RESOURCES,
18 AND TO DISPROPORTIONATELY IMPACTED COMMUNITIES, AS DEFINED IN
19 SECTION 24-4-109 (2)(b)(II).

20 (IV) AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION (11)(d), "IMPACTS TO CLIMATE"
21 MEANS QUANTIFICATION OF EMISSIONS OF GREENHOUSE GASES, AS
22 DEFINED IN SECTION 25-7-140 (6), THAT OCCUR FROM SOURCES THAT ARE
23 CONTROLLED OR OWNED BY THE OPERATOR AND REASONABLY
24 FORESEEABLE TRUCK TRAFFIC AT AN OIL AND GAS LOCATION."
