(III) The exeeutive director of the department of human serviees, or his or her designee THE COMMISSIONER OF THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH ADMINISTRATION, OR THE COMMISSIONER'S DESIGNEE;
(IV) The exeeutive direetor of the department of higher edueation, or his or her designee A REPRESENTATIVE OF HIGHER EDUCATION WITH EXPERTISE IN THE TOPIC OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE;
(XI) Thirteen members MEMBERS appointed by the governor as follows:
(C) Anexpert in juvenile justice issues,
(F) A Two criminal defense attorney ATTORNEYS, AT LEAST ONE OF WHOM MUST BE AN ATTORNEY IN A RURAL JUDICIAL DISTRICT;
(H) One member who is a representative of a eommminity eorrections provider, a community corrections board member, or a behavioral, mental health, or substance use disorder treatment provider;
(H.5) ONE MEMBER WHO IS A REPRESENTATIVE OF A COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS PROVIDER OR A COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS BOARD;
(M) Two members who shallbe appointed at-large ONE MEMBER WHO WORKS WITH A COMMUNITY-BASED REENTRY PROGRAM.
(6) The commission shall meet at least once per month or on a schedule determined by the chairperson to review information necessary for making recommendations. THE CHAIRPERSON SHALL MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO SCHEDULE MEETINGS AT A TIME AND LOCATION, AND IN A MANNER, THAT MAXIMIZES PARTICIPATION BY ALL INTERESTED PARTIES.".
