- 6 "SECTION 10. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-1.3-406, amend 7 (1)(d) as follows:
  - **18-1.3-406. Mandatory sentences for violent crimes - definitions.** (1) (d) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1)(a) of this section, any person convicted of a sex offense, as defined in section 18-1.3-1003 (5):
  - (I) Committed on or after November 1, 1998, BUT PRIOR TO OCTOBER 1, 2024, that constitutes a crime of violence shall be sentenced to the department of corrections for an indeterminate term of incarceration of at least the midpoint in the presumptive range specified in section 18-1.3-401 (1)(a)(V)(A) or (1)(a)(V)(A.1) up to a maximum of the person's natural life, as provided in section 18-1.3-1004 (1), AS IT EXISTED PRIOR TO OCTOBER 1, 2024; or
- (II) COMMITTED ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2024, THAT CONSTITUTES A CRIME OF VIOLENCE SHALL BE SENTENCED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR A DETERMINATE TERM OF INCARCERATION OF AT LEAST THE UPPER LIMIT IN THE PRESUMPTIVE RANGE SPECIFIED IN SECTION 18-1.3-401(1)(a)(V)(A.1), AND A TERM OF INDETERMINATE PAROLE AS PROVIDED FOR IN SECTION 18-1.3-1006;
- 25 EXCEPT THAT ANY PERSON CONVICTED OF A CRIME OF VIOLENCE
- 26 PURSUANT TO SECTION 18-1.3-1004 (1)(e) SHALL BE SENTENCED TO THE
- 27 DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR AN INDETERMINATE TERM OF
- 28 INCARCERATION UP A MAXIMUM OF THE PERSON'S NATURAL LIFE, AS
- 29 PROVIDED IN SECTION 18-1.3-1004 (1)(e).".
- 30 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- Page 18, line 26, strike "applies" and substitute "sections 4 and 5 of the
- 32 act apply".
