1 Amend printed bill, page 21, after line 12 insert:

2 "SECTION 5. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 1-13.5-902, amend
3 (8)(a) as follows:

4 1-13.5-902. Ballots and sample ballots - delivery - format. 5 (8) (a) The extreme top part of each ballot must be divided by two 6 perforated or dotted lines into two spaces, each of which must be not less than one inch in width, the top portion being known as the stub and the 7 8 next portion as the duplicate stub. Upon each of said stubs nothing is to be printed except the number of the ballot, WHICH NUMBER MUST BE 9 10 PROCEDURALLY UNASSOCIABLE TO ANY VOTER'S IDENTITY, and the same 11 number must be printed on both stubs. Stubs and duplicate stubs of 12 ballots must both be numbered consecutively. There must be printed on 13 the stub of an absentee ballot "Absentee Ballot Number [...]", and such 14 stubs must be numbered consecutively beginning with number one. All 15 ballots must be uniform and of sufficient length and width to allow for the 16 names of candidates and the proposed questions to be printed in clear, plain type with a space of at least one-half inch between the different 17 18 columns on said ballot. On each ballot must be printed the endorsement "official ballot for . . .", and after the word "for" must follow the 19 20 designation of the local government for which the ballot is prepared, the 21 date of the election, and a facsimile of the signature of the designated 22 election official. The ballot shall not contain any caption or other 23 endorsement or number. Each designated election official shall use precisely the same quality and tint of paper, the same kind of type, and the 24 25 same quality and tint of plain black ink for all ballots furnished by the 26 designated election official at one election.".
