

HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Third Reading

BY REPRESENTATIVES Willford and Young

1 Amend engrossed bill, page 2, line 11, after "credit;" add "and".

2 Page 2, strike lines 12 through 18.

3 Page 3, strike lines 1 through 10 and substitute:

4 "(b) It is in the public interest that House Bill 23B-1002 be  
5 repealed and reenacted at the soonest possible time during the second  
6 regular session of the seventy-fourth general assembly, given that:

7 (I) Litigation was filed over House Bill 23B-1002's compliance  
8 with section 22 of article V of the state constitution providing for the  
9 reading of bills at length unless there is unanimous consent to waive such  
10 readings by the members present;

11 (II) The filing of that litigation has produced great financial  
12 uncertainty for state taxpayers and families eligible for the earned income  
13 tax credit; and

14 (III) The filing of that litigation has caused substantial  
15 administrative uncertainty for state government regarding the amount of  
16 the state earned income tax credit for 2023 and the amount of state  
17 revenue that may be expended in the current state fiscal year."
