Representative Soper moved to amend the Report of the Committee of the Whole to reverse the action taken by the Committee in adopting the following Mabrey amendment, (L.044) to HB24-1292, to show that said amendment lost and that HB24-1292, as amended, passed.

Amend the Judiciary Committee Report, dated March 19, 2024, Page 2, of the report, strike lines 1 through 3 and substitute:

"Page 15 of the bill, strike line 27.

Page 16 of the bill, strike lines 1 though 7 and substitute:

- "(3) (a) An individual or entity that does not have a permit to sell firearms but sells or attempts to make a private sale of a rapid-fire trigger activator in violation of subsection (1) of this section on or after July 1, 2025, shall be assessed a civil penalty in the amount of seven hundred and fifty dollars.
- (b) A LICENSED GUN DEALER, LICENSED FIREARMS DEALER, GUN SHOW VENDOR, OR OTHER PERSON THAT HAS A PERMIT TO SELL FIREARMS WHO SELLS OR ATTEMPTS TO SELL A RAPID-FIRE TRIGGER ACTIVATOR IN VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2025, SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE. THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE SHALL TAKE ACTIONS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
- (c) A LICENSED GUN DEALER, LICENSED FIREARMS DEALER, GUN SHOW VENDOR, OR OTHER PERSON THAT HAS A PERMIT TO SELL FIREARMS THAT PURCHASES A RAPID-FIRE TRIGGER ACTIVATOR FROM A MANUFACTURER OF RAPID-FIRE TRIGGER ACTIVATORS THAT OPERATES IN COLORADO SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE. THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE SHALL ACTIONS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.".".
