



The drawings show crown molding in all raise ceilings... use the same molding as the kitchen and butt-up against top of ceiling

Make top of all raised ceilings in all rooms the same color as the walls

Make all crown molding the same as the one shown in the kitchen...the kitchen seems to be the only place with the correct thickness

Raise all interior door and hallway opening heights to 10'-0"

This is an elevator door...delete the door knob and just change the door to a frosted glass look

There is no door and no frame here...also the drawings show an arch opening at 10 foot

Make all crown molding and base boards pure white

Darken this round table...same brown, just a darker shade as shownn





Place a chandelier over the dining table that has a similar look to this

Place rugs under dining table and living room couch and chairs

Darken wood on dining room chairs just like the round table in the living room...client wants them to be darker than the table

This chair seems low for being in front of a bar...replace these chairs with the same ones used for the other bar

Delete the entire shaded portion of wall and molding. Basically, the client wants a completely open kitchen with a 42 inch high and 18 inch wide counter top with the same color as the other kitchen counter tops. Make the counter color a light colored granite so that the granite look shows though more...a light gray color would be best.

Delete this counter top feature and replace with an actual counter top

Make this portion of the wall the same texture as the cabinets





Use roof colors that make the tile look more like the image shown here.

Use paver colors that make the driveway look more like the image shown here.



Use trees and the same background image used in the original two renderings.

Place a car in two of the driveways in a way that least blocks the view of anything else



Whatever you use for the foxtail palm between the driveway, use the same for these trees in the pool area. These are too bushy.

Change view per the attached image.

Move gate from the 2nd opening to the front opening

Delete this tree and don't replace (it blocks the gate)

Replace these trees with something that more closely matches a foxtail palm, shown in the image attached. The main thing is that the trunk is too thick and the leaves are too bushy.

Delete these plants and don't replace with anything else

Make the mulched area not so square shaped but rather use curves

Use the grass texture from the Longbar street renderings. This doesn't look as good





Place a couple of people in the pool area

In the first renderings, there was a brown border trim used, as shown right. Use this same color in this same way again.



Change this door color to match the garage



Try to reorient or move these chairs in a way that shows them better.



This color matches exactly what the color should look like in direct sunlight, Peace Yellow (shown right)...

In some areas it looks too pink and should look more yellow. In the double arch area it is washed out. Adjust the color slightly to show more yellow and make the lighting more like the first rendering where the colors weren't as washed out and it didn't look like such a hot and bright sunny day.



Use a nice tropical looking plant here and at the other pedestal that covers the pedestal and hangs down slightly (almost to the ground)
