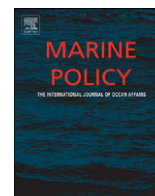

The authors of the above paper have notified the Publisher of the following errata:

- Page 221, Section 2 (Methods), penultimate sentence before Section 3 (Results). The current sentence should be replaced with the following: “Finally, a longline fleet targeting tuna and other large pelagic species (e.g. swordfish, marlin) operates in Madagascar’s waters from La Reunion (France; [38]), but catches are uncertain [33].”
- Page 221, Fig. 3b. The ‘tuna and billfishes’ items have been incorrectly labelled. The correct labels are indicated below:

- In the legend for Fig. 3b, ‘pole-and-line’ should be replaced with ‘longline’.
