Be sure, when you ask for a reference, that you get permission to use the reference in your new business. You may also want to ask permission to use their photo and at least their first name when sharing the reference.

A great way to get a reference is to offer to write it for them! You'll get it back faster and it will say exactly what you need it to say to help prospects know your skills.
