Boho Botanical Papercut Wreath

Tools

Scissors
Low-temp hot glue gun
Wire cutters
Cutting machine or craft scissors

Materials

Paper covered wire
Metallic text weight paper
Paper-Papers.com: Pure Gold, Emerald, Ruby, Botanic, Fairway, Copper
Paper Source: Persimmon, Peacock, Moss, Chartreuse, Fuchsia, Beet

Instructions

1. Gather tools & materials.
2. Score the leaves using your scissors along the fold lines.
3. Curl the delicate paper ferns by gently rolling the tips around a pencil or glue stick.
4. Use the back of your scissors to curl the bugs and feathers
5. Once all your pieces are cut and curled, create a circular wreath base by wrapping paper covered wire around 8 times; ours is 8" in diameter.
6. Use a low-temp glue gun to secure the largest leaves to the wreath at the base; don't be too rigid, and keep it relaxed looking.
7. Glue the largest ferns closer to the front of the wreath; only put glue at the tips of your ferns to allow the ends to curl away for added dimension.
8. Glue on the green ferns and leaves; begin to layer and stick some ferns directly onto the largest leaves.
9. Add the feathers closer in and around the wreath in various directions; poke some ends through the wreath itself.
10. Glue the plum colored leaves into place; the leaves can stick out at an angle for added texture.
11. Places the little bugs around the wreath and glue into place.
12. Pull away any glue strings; sit back and admire your work!
