Metallic Paper Succulents

Tools

Scissors
Low-Temp Hot Glue Gun
Wire Cutter
Cutting Machine (recommended)

Materials

Metallic Paper - Ruby, Botanic, & Lime Satin
Copic Markers - Blue Violet, Grass Green, & Veronese Green
20-Gauge Floral Wire

Instructions

1. Gather tools and materials.
2. Cut out paper according to pattern, or use a cutting machine.
3. Use markers to shade the tips of the succulent leaves.
4. Curl the succulent leaves gently as shown.
5. For the bigger succulent, glue and cross over tabs at base.
6. **Bigger succulent** - glue together 3 of the biggest leaves at the base. Poke length of floral wire through the middle of the base and make a small loop at the end. Glue in place.
Spiky succulent - poke wire through the biggest piece and make a small loop at the end. Glue in place.
Scallop edge succulent - glue a length of floral wire between 2 leaves.
7. Glue and stack succulent pieces biggest to smallest.
8. Place foam and then moss in a vase or container, then poke the succulents into place.
