Yarn Wall Hanging

Tools

Scissors
Yarn Needle

Materials

10 in Embroidery Hoop
7 1/5" Embroidery Hoop
3 Different Colors of Yarn
Wooden Bead

Instructions

1. Gather tools and materials. Try to pick out 3 different colors of wool-mix yarn in various textures for more visual interest.
2. Pop the solid inner rings out of the embroidery hoops.
3. Precut yarn double the length you want it to hang down.
4. Fold yarn in half and place loop under larger embroidery hoop.
5. Pull the end of the yarn through the loop.
6. Pull the end tight against the hoop. Continue looping yarn onto the embroidery hoop going the same direction.
7. Fill in about 1/4 of the hoop with the yarn.
8. Repeat process with the smaller hoop, using a different yarn. If you use big fluffy yarn, you will probably need to cut and loop less strands.
9. Lay the smaller hoop on top of the bigger one, matching the top edges. It is up to you which side you want to face out, one side being more knotted looking than the other.
10. Tie a knot around the two hoops in a third yarn. Begin wrapping the top, leaving a big loop for hanging in the middle.
11. Tie a knot at the base of the loop and continue wrapping the hoops together.
12. Thread the end of the yarn onto a yarn needle and tie a knot. Tuck end into the wrapping on the back.
13. Put a wooden bead on the loop and tie another knot.
14. Hang up the yarn wall hanging and trim the yarn ends as desired. You can cut the ends in a "V", at an angle, straight across, or leave it uneven!
