## *Materials List & Instructions*

### Felt Narwhal

#### **TOOLS**

Low temp hot glue gun  
Scissors  
Wooden skewer or chopstick  
Sewing Needle

#### **MATERIALS**

Art Markers – Tombow in Black (N15)  
Felt – Benzie in White and Silver  
Embroidery Floss – White (B5200), Gray (648)  
2 small buttons  
Polyfill

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Gather tools and materials.
2. Cut felt pieces according to pattern.
3. Blanket stitch sides of tusk; use a dowel to stuff polyfill in as you sew.
4. Blanket stitch fins, then stuff with polyfill; use a dowel if needed.
5. Blanket stitch the middle of each body piece.
6. Lightly glue in tusk and fins to the sides of white bottom piece.
7. Sew button eyes to gray top piece.
8. Blanket stitch two body pieces together, leaving an opening.
9. Stuff narwhal body with polyfill; use dowel if needed.
10. Draw dots on the fins and back of body with black art marker.
