## Crepe Paper Artichokes

### TOOLS

Low-Temp Hot Glue Gun  
Scissors  
Paint Brush

### MATERIALS

Double Sided Crepe Paper - Lia Griffith in "Ferns + Moss"  
PanPastel - in "Magenta"  
Art Foam - 4" Egg Shape

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Gather tools and materials.
2. Cut the crepe paper according to pattern notes using scissors or the Cricut Maker.
3. Using a the paint brush color the base of the artichoke leaves with the magenta PanPastel.
4. Stretch the artichoke leaves from the center.
5. Roll the 8 inch strip of crepe paper to make the stem, glue the end into place.
6. Use the end of the paint brush to make a hole in the larger end of the foam egg.
7. Cover the egg with the square cut of crepe paper, stretch it to fit and glue it into place.
8. Glue the stem into the hole you made in step 6.
9. Starting at the end opposite the stem glue 2 layers of the smallest leaves (about 12 leaves) evenly around the egg.
10. Glue 2 layers of the medium sized leaves around the egg using bout 12 leaves.
11. Glue one layer of about 6 of the largest leaves around the stem.
12. To finish glue one or two of the smallest leaves to the stem.
