Materials List & Instructions

Extra-Fine Crepe Paper Ranunculus

TOOLS

Cutting Machine (recommended)
Low-Temp Hot Glue Gun
Scissors
Curling Tool

MATERIALS

Extra Fine Crepe Paper - Lia Griffith "Fern", "Vanilla", "Blush", and "Coral"
Green Paper Covered Floral Wire - 18 Gauge
Foam Ball -
Tacky Glue

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Gather tools and materials.
2. Cut crepe paper according to pattern notes.
3. Curl the crepe petals with the grain lines using the curling tool.
4. Using your fingers gently stretch and cup the center of each petal .
5. Glue the foam ball to the end of the wire stem.
6. Cover the ball with the fern crepe paper petals allowing the tops to ruffle around the ball.
7. Glue the vanilla petals in rotation around the center, place in layers of 6 petals.
8. Repeat step 7 with the blush petals.
9. Glue the larger coral petals in rotation around the base of the flower, allow the petals to ruffle out and away from the flowers center.
10. Glue the smaller coral petals in rotation around the base of the flower.
11. When gluing the last layer of petals place them neatly around the stem
12. Cut out the leaves according to template notes.
13. Curl the leaves using the curling tool
14. Glue a wire between two leaves using hot glue
