Materials List & Instructions

Pom Pom Cockatoo

TOOLS

Low-Temp Hot Glue Gun

Scissors

Micro-Tip Scissors (recommended)

Pom Pom Makers (2 sizes) - Clover 1 3/8" and 1 5/8"

MATERIALS

Felt - Benzie Design "White", "Blush", "Smoke", and "Yellow"

Acrylic Yarn - Knit Picks Brava Sport "White" and "Cotton Candy"(similar)

2 Black Beads - 6mm

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Gather tools and materials.
2. Make 2 pom poms for the bird - Wrap the smallest pom pom maker with pink yarn, and the bigger one with 3/4 white and 1/4 pink yarn.
3. Finish making the pom poms and trim evenly.
4. Tie the head and body together with the pink part of the body meeting the head. Trim the ends. You can also just trim off the ties first and glue the head to the body to get it in the correct spot.
5. Cut out felt according to pattern. Micro-tip scissors makes cutting out the small detailed pieces easier.
6. Glue together the beak and head feathers as shown, so that they are double-sided.
7. Part the yarn in the middle of the head and glue on the beak and feathers.
8. Trim away the yarn a bit and glue on the beads for eyes. You can give the face a little more shape with the smaller scissors.
9. Glue together the tail and wing pieces as shown.
10. Part the yarn at the base of bird and glue on the tail feathers.
11. Glue the tops of the wings to the side of the bird and the two feet under the body.
12. Make a classic cockatoo using all white yarn and yellow felt instead of pink.
