TOOLS & MATERIALS

Hot Glue Gun

Needle-Nose Pliers/Wire Cutters

Scissors or Curling Tool

Green Floral Wire — 18- and 24-Gauge

Green Floral Tape (*optional*)

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Gently punch flower petals and leaves from stack.
2. Use edge of scissors or curling tool to gently curl the flower center and stamen to create cup shapes. Form center into ball; then glue center ball inside stamen.
3. Gently curl each petal upward to form cup, and then curl slightly back on both side points of petals.
4. Gently curl leaf in different directions.
5. Bend tip of 18-gauge wire 45 degrees.
6. Slide two sets of petals onto the wire. Glue together offset then slide up to meet bend of wire.
7. Add glue on top of bent wire at center of petals. Place center of flower into glue and secure.
8. Slide sepal onto the wire; then glue in place on the backside of the petals.
9. Glue leaf onto base of flower.
10. Curl the remainder of leaves; then glue 24-gauge wire between two leaves.
11. (Optional) Cover wires with floral tape and wrap the leaf stems to the flower stems.
