TOOLS & MATERIALS

Hot Glue Gun

Needle-Nose Pliers/Wire Cutters

Scissors or Curling Tool

Green Floral Wire — 18- and 24-Gauge

Green Floral Tape (*optional*)

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Gently punch flower petals and leaves from stack.
2. Use edge of scissors or curling tool to shape petals for blooms and buds. Your larger petals can be curled on both sides and the center to form a cup shape.
3. Fold leaf in half; then shape edges with curling tool.
4. Bend tip of 18-gauge floral wire 45 degrees and slide into hole of smallest petal and glue into place; glue tips of petals together to form ball center.
5. Slide each petal set in order of size onto wire, rotating petals. Glue each layer into place.
6. Slide small green sepal onto wire and glue under bloom.
7. For bud, repeat step 4. Overlay matching piece with no center hole over the top of bud and glue into place. Slide large green sepal into place and glue.
8. Glue 24-gauge wire between two offset leaves.
9. (Optional) Cover wires with floral tape and wrap the leaf stems to the flower stems.
