

gerbera daisies

TOOLS & MATERIALS

Hot Glue Gun
Needle-Nose Pliers/Wire Cutters
Scissors or Curling Tool
Green Floral Wire — 18- and 24-Gauge
Green Floral Tape (*optional*)

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Gently punch flower petals and leaves from stack.
2. Use edge of scissors or curling tool to crease the middle of petals 1, 2, and 3, creating vein lines.
3. With curling tool, gently curl the petals on pieces 4-8.
4. Glue petals 1-3 together at their centers, staggering the petals.
5. Glue petals 4-8 together, staggering the petals in the same way.
6. Add the small green center disk into the small petal cluster.
7. Bundle three 18-gauge floral wires and wrap them with floral tape, leaving one inch of wires uncovered.
8. Bend the three tips in three directions at an angle.
9. Glue green sepal into cone and slide onto wire bundle.
10. Glue inside sepal and over wire; then place on back of daisy to secure stem.
11. Attach the bloom to the floral wires.
12. Glue 24-gauge wire between two offset leaves.
13. (Optional) Cover wires with floral tape and wrap the leaf stems to the flower stems.
