TO BE FILMED.**

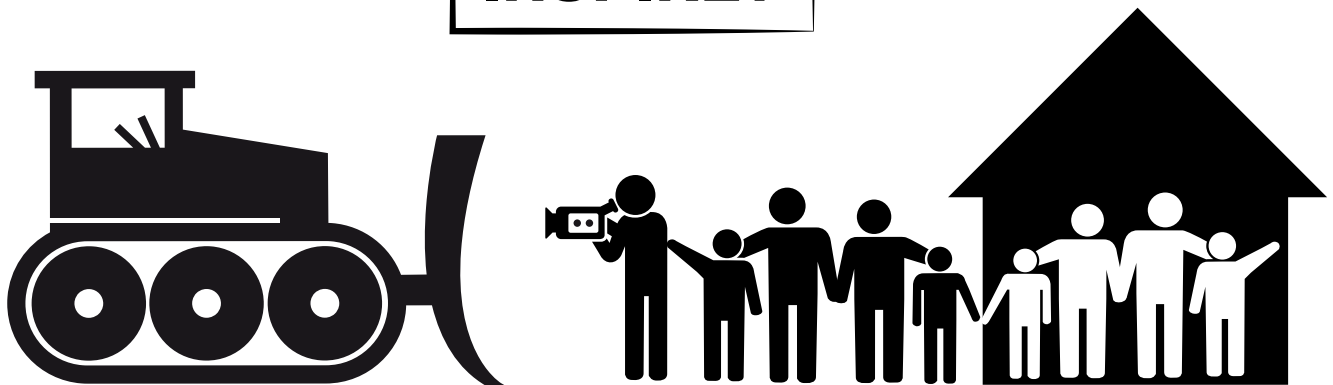
**RECORD DETAILS
