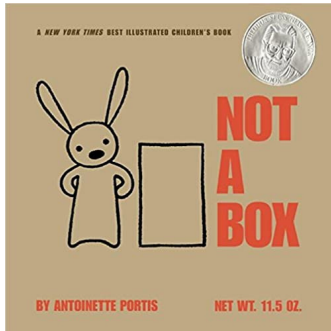

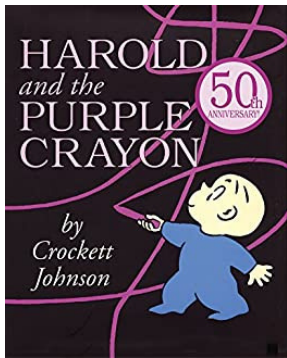

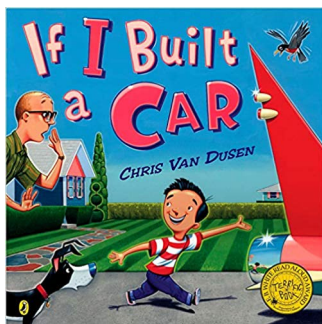

With an oversize purple crayon, young Harold creates his own world of wonder and excitement. Full of funny twists and surprises, this charming story shows just how far your imagination can take you.

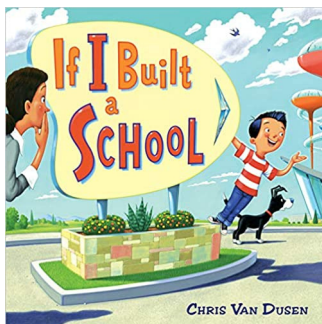

In this exuberant companion to *If I Built a Car*, a boy fantasizes about his dream school--from classroom to cafeteria to library to playground.

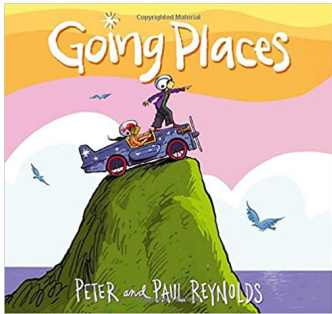

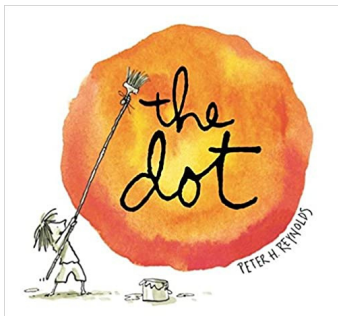

## GOING PLACES BY PETER AND PAUL REYNOLDS

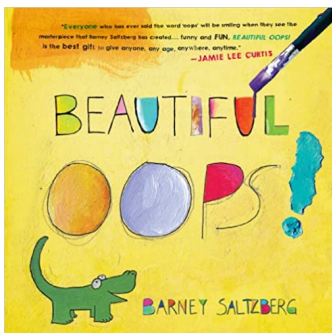
This sublime celebration of creative spirit and thinking outside the box both figuratively and literally is ideal for early learners, recent grads, and everyone in between.

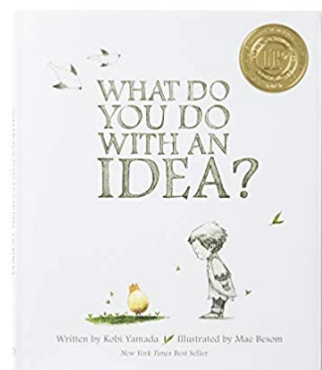
## THE DOT BY PETER REYNOLDS

A gentle mystery about a silent, gallant lion and a sweetly cheerful bird—two friends who are attracted to each other through the universal language of art.

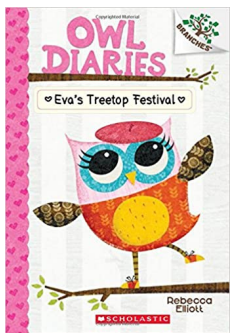
