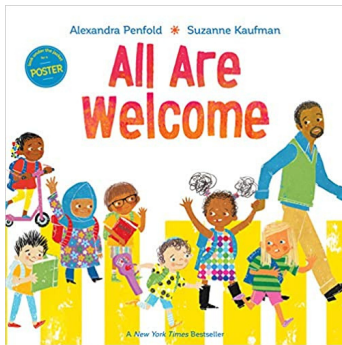

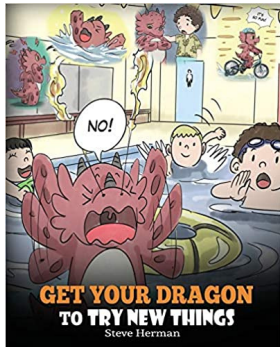

## **ALL ARE WELCOME** BY ALEXANDRA PENFOLD AND SUZANNE KAUFMAN

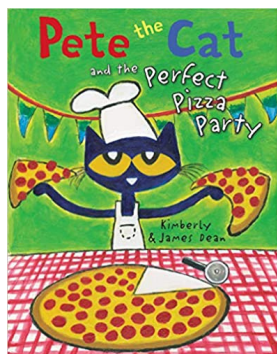
Discover a school where, no matter what, young children have a place, have a space, and are loved and appreciated

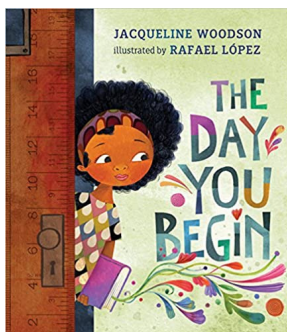
## **GET YOUR DRAGON TO TRY NEW THINGS** BY STEVE HERMAN

A poignant, yet heartening book about finding courage to connect, even when you feel scared and alone.

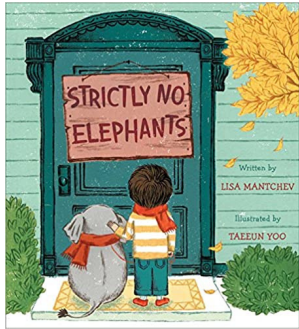

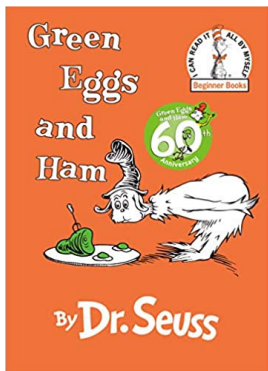

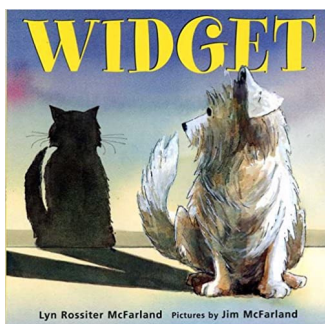
## GREEN EGGS AND HAM BY DR. SEUSS

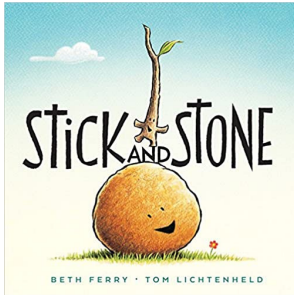
