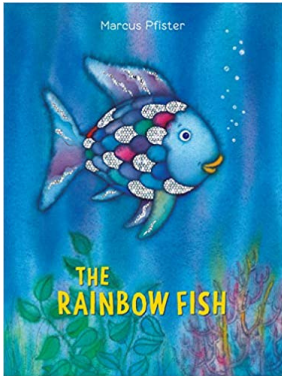

A simple story about a beautiful fish who learns to make friends by sharing his most prized possessions, gives this book its lasting value.

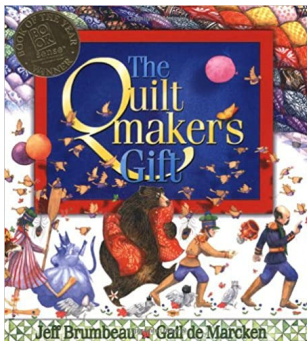

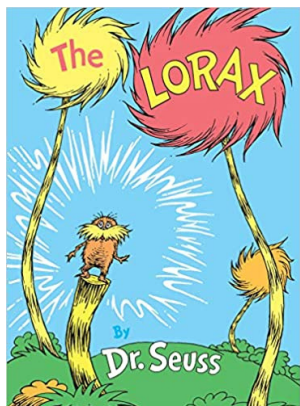
