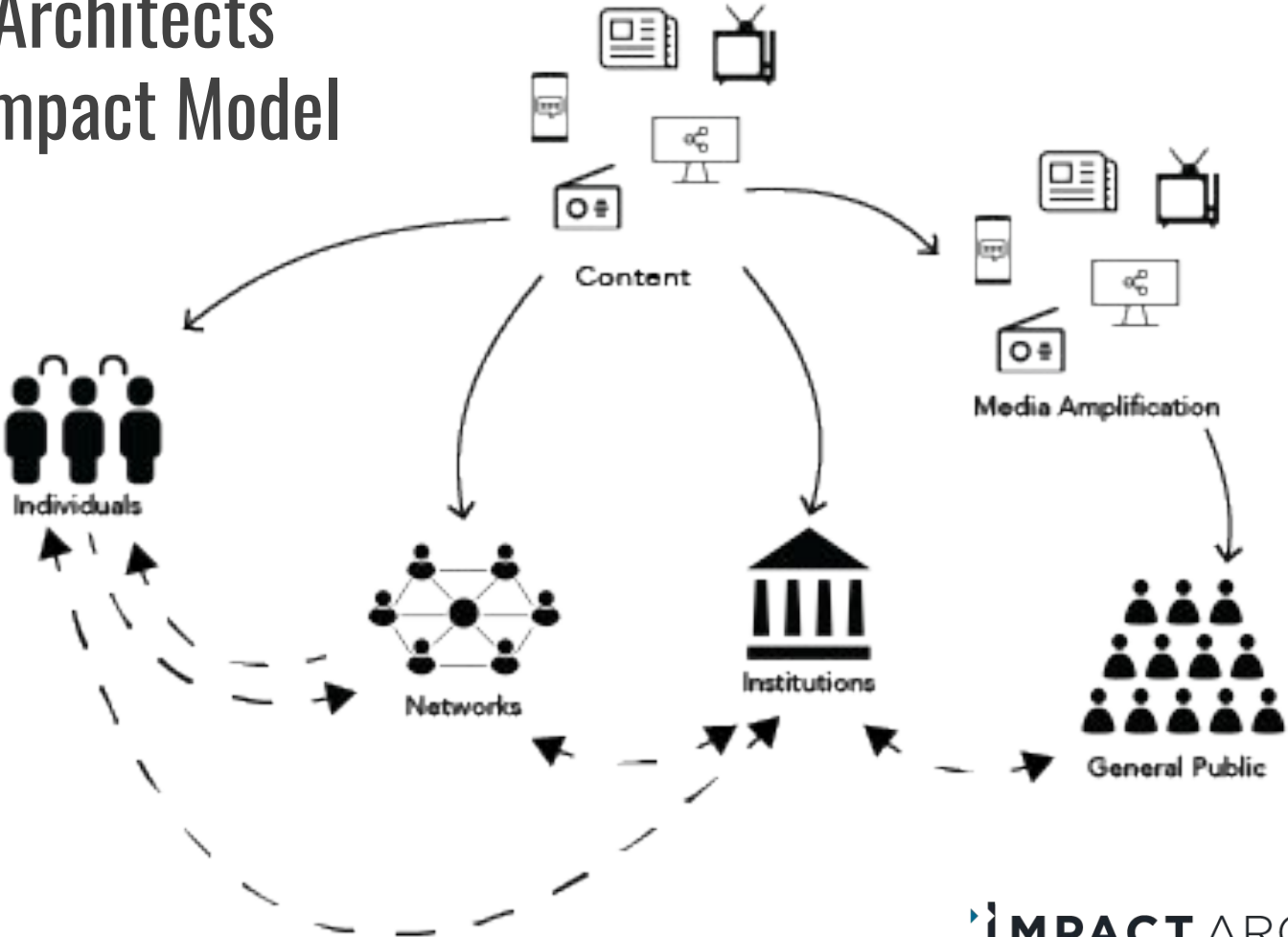
Impact?
