DEFINITIONS

“Number of Students Who Began Program” is the number of students who began the program who are scheduled to complete the program within the reporting calendar year.

“Students Available for Graduation” is the number of students who began program minus the number of “Students unavailable for graduation,” which means those students who have died, been incarcerated, or called to active military duty.

“On-Time Graduates” is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length.

“On-Time Completion Rate” is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.

“150% Graduates” is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).

“150% Completion Rate” is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.

“Graduates Available for Employment” means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.

“Graduates Unavailable for Employment” means graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.

“Graduates Employed in Field” means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment.

“Placement Rate Employed in Field” is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.

“Salary” is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.

“No Salary Info Reported” is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

Cancellation Refund Policy: Applicants who cancel within three business days of signing an enrollment agreement receive a full refund of all monies paid, including the application fee. Applicants who cancel more than three business days after signing an enrollment agreement but prior to entering school receive a full refund of all monies paid minus the \$50 application fee and a \$100 administrative fee.

Cancellation Procedure: Cancellation will occur when the student gives written notice of cancellation. The written notice need not take any particular form and, however expressed, is effective if it states that a student no longer wishes to be bound by the enrollment agreement, is signed by the student, and dated. Written notice of cancellation may be provided the following ways:

Notice of cancellation, if sent by U.S. Mail, is effective when deposited in the mail, properly addressed with postage prepaid.
