Snohomish County Lien Fee Increase

LIEN RECORDING FEES

NEW FEE: \$200 OLD FEE: \$70

The Washington State Legislature passed an increase in fees to record documents. The additional funds support homeless and affordable housing initiatives in Snohomish County and throughout the State.

Documents received by Snohomish County for recording on or after June 7th, 2018 must include the correct fee in order to be promptly recorded.

This recording fee increase for liens directly impacts our District customers who are delinquent in their sewer bills. If you are interested in automatic payments please contact our Customer Service Dept. Also, you may make payments online using Xpress Bill Pay (www.xpressbillpay.com).

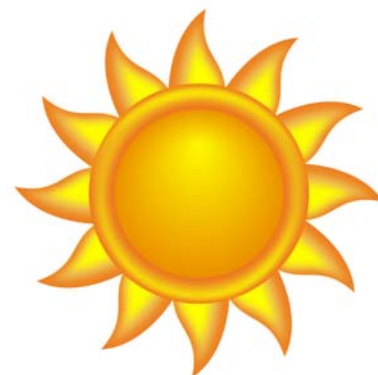

CALL BEFORE YOU DIG

With the nicer weather upon us many community members are planning home improvements, yard renovations, or building sheds, fences, or outbuildings. Please play it safe and call 811 before you dig. There are plenty of reasons to make sure you don't end up causing damage or incurring extra financial costs to your project.



Call 811 at least a few days before you start any digging project. Whether you are planning to do it yourself or hire a professional, smart digging means calling 811 before each job.

FOG (fats, oil and grease) is a billion dollar issue yearly nationwide. Businesses who self-report and are compliant can reduce their annual FOG fee if they send their 2018 information in by the end of January 2019

Tips on Avoiding Sewer Line Back-ups...

- Proteins, such as egg shells, bones and particles, etc., do not break down in the lines therefore this can clog the sewer.
- Items you should not put down your toilet or garbage disposal...

Disposable diapers, coffee grounds, tampons, paper towels, rags, hair, dental floss, seeds, peelings, wipes (even if they say flushable!)
