CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

South Lake Stevens Regional Lift Station & Forcemain Improvements Project

Right-of-way work to take place along Machias Cutoff and South Lake Stevens Road

October 2019 – April 2020

Work will be beginning on Tuesday, October 1, 2019 to construct a new sewer lift station on the corner of Machias Cutoff and 116th Ave SE. As construction progresses, the area of work will shift into the right-of-way to install new sewer infrastructure in multiple locations along Machias Cutoff and S Lake Stevens Rd (see map).



The right-of-way work included in this sewer improvement project will take place at the same time as the City of Lake Stevens roadway improvement project known as the South Lake Stevens Road Multi-Use Path Project. The Contractor for both projects is Strider Construction, Co. and they will be working directly with representatives from both the Lake Stevens Sewer District and City of Lake Stevens throughout the duration of both projects.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Typical work hours will be between 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM daily, four or five days a week. As a result of construction, lane closures are expected to occur between 116th Ave SE to 20th St SE, with complete road closures to most likely occur during January and February (exact dates to be announced). In order to reduce disruption to local businesses, nighttime and early morning work will be occurring around the Burger King and Tom Thumb grocery most likely during November and December (exact dates also to be announced).

TRAFFIC REVISIONS

During construction, traffic control will be in place in order for residents to access their homes and allow steady flow of traffic, however periodic delays should be expected. Your safety and that of our work crews is important. Please assist in our safety efforts by obeying all construction signs and staying away from construction. Please also be advised these dates and times are subject to change due to unforeseen operational factors or inclement weather.
