



The Clay Crusade - Summer Trap League Frequently Asked Questions (F.A. Q.)

Q: How many weeks do we shoot in the league?

A: We will be shooting a total of 6 weeks on Sundays. We will shoot on the following days: 7/10, 7/17, 7/24, 7/31, 8/7 and 8/14.

Q: How many shooters will be in the league?

A: We are limiting the number of participants to 75 shooters.

Q: What time do we shoot?

A: Shooting starts at 9 am and we will send the first squad to the line at that time. Generally, most shooting is complete by noon to 1pm. We intentionally do not schedule shooters to allow for some flexibility.

Q: What if I have a team?

A: This is an individual shooting event but if you like to shoot as a team or have a group you prefer to shoot with, we will do our best to squad you together.

Q: How much does it cost to shoot?

A: Each shoot is \$20.00 per shooter (3 rounds). To encourage our junior shooters (17 and under), the shoot fee will be waived when accompanied by a paying family member shooter.

Q: I do not want to shoot, can I just get someone else in the league to sponsor the junior?

A: No, we want to promote junior participation in shooting events but this league is focused on having family participation and the enjoyment of trap shooting.

Q: I do not want to shoot the league, can I still come out on a Sunday and just shoot?

A: No. The purpose of the league is to present a well organized and committed shooting event at the trap venue. The trap venue will be closed to all non-league shooters (club members and non-members) during the league.

Q: It's summer and shooters go on vacation. What if I cannot make all 6 shoots?

A: We know that summers mean vacations and sometimes you have to miss a shoot. The league committee will allow make-ups for missed shoots under special circumstances.

Weeks 1-4: makeup must be shot by the 5th Sunday, 8/7/16

Week 5: makeup must be shot ahead of week 5

Week 6: makeup must be shot ahead of week 6.

No make-ups will be allowed on the final shoot day.

If you know that you are going to miss a shoot, you may also shoot ahead for that week. Be prepared to pay the league shoot fee when you shoot the makeup.

IMPORTANT: Shooters must complete all 6 shoots to be eligible for awards and challenge coins.

Q: How will divisions be determined?

A: Divisions will be determined based on total birds for weeks 1-3. The league committee reserves the right to place shooters with known ability in an appropriate division if necessary. The purpose of this league is to promote a fun competitive event with fairness for all shooting abilities.

If you miss a shoot in weeks 1 through 3 and do not complete a make-up shoot, your score will be averaged for the completed shoots and you will be placed 1 division higher than your normal standing had you completed all 3 shoots.

Week 1 : Score 74

Week 2: Score 70

Week 3: Missed

You will be assigned a score of 72 for the missed shoot for purposes of division ranking only. However, you must make up the shoot in order to have targets added to your total.

If the total of 216 (74+70+72) places you in Division 3, then you will automatically be placed in Division 2.

Q: Will there be division awards for the league?

A: For registered league participants, we will have special awards for each division. The overall number of divisions will depend on the total number of league participants.

In addition, each shooter who completes all 6 shoots, will receive a custom made challenge coin for league participation. These coins are highly sought after by some shooters and a great token of the experience. Don't miss out!

Q: Will there be an Awards Lunch this year?

A: Yes, lunch and awards presentation will be held on 8/14/2016 after the last shoot is complete. Registered league shooters who complete all 6 shoots are eligible for the lunch and awards.

Q: Can I bring my family to the Awards Lunch?

A: Each shooter is entitled to one guest at the lunch. Additional guests may attend at an additional cost of \$10.00 per guest. We ask that your league coordinators (Paul Vanderpool, Gary Schmidt) be notified and payment made for any additional guests, by the second to last shoot (8/7/2016) so that proper food and drink amounts are obtained.
