CODE OF ETHICS

To achieve these three goals, our members pledge to uphold the following Code of Ethics:

- Conduct our business in a manner that will reflect credit upon our Association, our industry and ourselves.
- Avoid statements or implications that may be misleading or deceptive.
- Describe accurately and honestly the price, materials and standards of workmanship used in our jobs.
- Provide high standards of health and safety.
- Deal fairly with everyone involved in our projects including employees, subcontractors, suppliers and customers.
- Encourage research to develop new materials, building techniques, improved building practices and financing methods.
- Perform to the standards of the NAHB residential-construction performance guideline in effect at the time of construction.
- Offer a minimum one-year written warranty on new homes and remodels, and use the MBA's consumer dispute resource program to settle disagreements with builders and remodelers of single-family homes should the Association receive a complaint.
- Support our local, state and national associations and all related industries concerned with providing affordable housing.
- Certify that, as a contractor member of the Master Builders Association, we are registered, bonded and insured with the state of Washington.
- Do business with Association members whenever possible.

We, as individual members, assume these responsibilities freely and solemnly, mindful that they are part of our obligation as members of the Master Builders Association of King and Snohomish Counties.
