Read Mark 8:27 – 33

Introduction: *Jesus asked the disciples who other people thought He was; then He asked them the same question. It is not enough to know what others say about Jesus; you must know, understand, and accept for yourself that He is the Messiah. You must move from curiosity to commitment, from admiration to adoration.*

Application Study Bible

1. Read Mark 8:28, Matthew 16:14 and Luke 9:18-19. What was the rumor among the people of who they identified Jesus as being?

One of the most important questions we could ever ask ourselves is who is Jesus? The world will say that Jesus is a good man, a great teacher and an insightful prophet. But who is Jesus? Who did He claim to be?

3. According to Mark 8:31 what did Jesus begin to teach and prophesy to His disciples?

- Isaiah prophesied of the suffering of the Savior. What further understanding and detail do we discover in Isaiah 53:3 – 6?

- Psalm 22: 1, 14 – 18 gives to us even more detailed account of the suffering of the Messiah. How do these verses describe the crucifixion Christ faced?
