Lesson 24

Read Daniel 11:40 – 45 (Read NKJ & NLT)

Introduction: These final verses in Daniel chapter 11 describe the awful, frightful and destructive reign of the coming Antichrist. He will blaspheme God in unthinkable and unheard of ways. He will worship the god of fortresses meaning he will worship power and making war. He will sweep through many countries like a flood, including Israel, Egypt, and Libya. In hearing some alarming news from the east and the north, he will return in great anger, destroying those along the way as he comes to a valley called Megiddo. This is a geographical location in northern Israel that is an extended plain that reaches from the Mediterranean Sea to the Northern part of the land of Israel. It is in this valley that the battle of Armageddon will take place. However, the Antichrist and his forces will not be defeated by man but by the Living God according to Revelation 19:17 – 21.

5. According to Daniel 11:44 – 45 what will take place to cause the Antichrist to change directions? (Compare with Revelation 16:12 – 16)
