Survey your ideal clients

- 1. Use SurveyMonkey.com (FREE if you use <10 questions)
- 2. Test your survey questions in the Facebook Group for feedback
- 3. Create your survey **this** week
- 4. Send your survey out **this** week to your target audience/ideal client. For example:
 - a. FaceBook groups that relate to your topic
 - b. Your FaceBook page
 - c. Your email list/personal contacts
 - d. LinkedIn page & groups
 - e. Twitter
 - f. Instagram
 - g. Give paper surveys if you are going to in-person networking groups
- 5. Offer a FREE gift for participating.
- 6. Be sure to thank your participants!

Interview your ideal clients

- 1. Use Skype/www.freeconferencing.com/in person
- 2. Record the calls if you can (so you can be present asking questions)
- 3. Offer a ½ & ½ call: the first half you ask your questions/test assumptions and the 2nd half, you can offer them a problem solving/coaching session.
- 4. Your psychology: stay open and inquisitive. This is **not** a sales conversation! Your only job is to ask questions and see if/how you can help them in the future.
- 5. Pay attention to "their language". How do they describe their problem/issue? These words will be key in you market your new business going forward
