





RURAL CUSTOMERS

There are basically three types of automatic party line telephone sets installed in Alberta, described as follows:

AUTOMATIC ELECTRIC—The HOOK SWITCH LATCH is located on the lower left side of the telephone set.

NORTHERN ELECTRIC—The CALL BUTTON is located on the upper right side of the telephone set.

ETELCO —The CALL BUTTON is located on the front of the telephone set near the dial.

HOW TO USE AUTOMATIC PARTY LINE TELEPHONES

1. TO CALL EXCHANGE SUBSCRIBERS AND OTHER PARTY LINE SUBSCRIBERS:

- (a) Lift the receiver. If the line is free, push in the "Call" button or press the "Hook Switch Latch" (depending on the type of telephone set).
- (b) Listen for dial tone, then dial the number as listed in the directory.

2. TO CALL A SUBSCRIBER ON YOUR OWN LINE:

- (a) Lift the receiver. If the line is free, push in the "Call" button or press the Hook Switch Latch.
- (b) Listen for dial tone, then dial the number as listed in the directory.
- (c) When you hear the busy signal, depress the hook switch until the "Call" button or Hook Switch Latch releases and listen.
- (d) When your party answers, push in the "Call" button or press the Hook Switch Latch and proceed with your conversation.

3. IF THE CALLED PARTY DOES NOT ANSWER:

Push in the "Call" button or press Hook Switch Latch to stop the ringing and replace the receiver.

EXTENDED AREA SERVICE

There is no toll charge for calls between the following places. Just dial the listed number.

with direct distance dialing you can dial station - to - station long distance calls to telephone numbers throughout Canada, the U.S. and Mexico which have seven numerals or two letters and five numerals.

(do not dial the area code)

for example: _____ telephone number
to call 489-5700 in Edmonton dial "1" + 489-5700

to call outside area 403 _____ dial "1" then the distant area code
and telephone number

to call 555-2368 in Vancouver dial "1" + 604 + 555-2368

to obtain a distant area code:

area codes for some cities are on page 5. If the place you want is not listed, dial "0" (zero) and ask operator.

to reach long distance directory assistance

- ◆ dial "1" plus the area code for the place you want plus 555-1212. For numbers in Area 403 dial "1" plus 555-1212. See page 5.
- ◆ tell the operator the city or town, then the name or place you want.
- ◆ there is no charge for directory assistance calls.

if you reach a wrong number

- ◆ dial "0" (zero) immediately and tell the operator what happened. She will make sure you aren't charged for the call.

you will not be charged

- ◆ if you hang up before you dial the complete number.
- ◆ if the telephone number you dial is busy or does not answer.

if you need assistance

dial "0" (zero) the operator will be glad to help you.

Reduced Evening and Sunday Rates . . .

Low night rates are in effect from 6 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. weekdays and all day Sunday. Alberta time determines the rate you pay.



long distance calls

long distance calls requiring operator assistance

types of calls

person-to-person

call person-to-person when you wish to talk to a particular person or extension telephone. Tell the "Operator" you wish to make a person-to-person call. Rates are higher than station-to-station.

collect

you can call "collect" if the person or firm you are calling agrees to pay the charge. If you want to make a "collect" call, please be sure to tell the "Operator" when you place the call.

station-to-station

call station-to-station if you will talk with anyone who answers. Rates are lower than person-to-person. Charging begins when the called telephone answers.

conference

you can talk with several people in different places at the same time. Tell the "Operator" you wish to make a conference call.

mobile and marine service

you can make local and long distance calls to automobiles, trucks and ships equipped for mobile telephone service. Ask the "Operator" for the Mobile Service Operator, or the Marine Operator.

overseas service

calls to most of the world's telephones can be made from your telephone. Tell the "Operator" you wish to place an overseas call and give her the name of the country you are calling. For overseas rates just dial "0" (Zero) and ask the Operator.

how to make calls

- 1** dial "0" (zero) to reach the "Operator".
- 2** give the operator:
 - the area code and telephone number you wish to call if you know them.
 - if you don't know the area code check the area code list on page 5 or give the name of the city you wish to call.
 - if you don't know the number give the name and address of the person you wish to call.
- 3** give the number you are calling from when the operator asks for it.

YOUR BUSINESS OFFICE REPRESENTATIVE

Your account is handled by a representative at the Business Office who will help you in any service requirement. She will arrange for new or additional telephone service, a move or disconnection of service, listings in the directory, and advertising. She will also answer questions about your bill or payments, and will furnish information on other telephone matters. For Business Office Dial "0" (Zero) and ask for Business Office (No Toll Charge)

THE "BEEP" TONE

If you hear a short beep tone about every 15 seconds it indicates that the person with whom you are talking is recording your conversation by means of an electrical recording machine connected to the line. The "beep" signal is produced automatically by a device which connects the recorder to the telephone line and is provided by the Telephone Company for your protection.

If you do not want a record made of what you are saying, ask the person with whom you are talking to disconnect his recording machine. When he disconnects his recorder, the signal is no longer heard.

Use of a recorder without this signal is not permitted.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

1. USE OF TELEPHONE

The service furnished is for the exclusive use of the customer and the members of his household or his employees, and the customer shall not extend use of the telephone to any other person nor shall the customer transmit messages for any other person.

If a residence telephone is used for business purposes, Alberta Government Telephone shall charge therefor the business rate.

The residence telephone number of a customer may be advertised only in conjunction with the advertising of the customer's business number.

The customer may use the telephone set and connecting lines where Alberta Government Telephones has placed them but nowhere else, and he shall not remove or alter them.

The customer shall be liable to Alberta Government Telephones for charges for all calls originating at his telephone regardless of who may originate such calls, and for all calls received at his telephone, the charges for which are accepted by any person receiving such calls, regardless of who may accept such charges. Alberta Government Telephones may if it so elects collect all or any part of such charges from the person placing the call or who may otherwise be responsible for the charges incurred.

The customer agrees to compensate Alberta Government Telephones on demand for any damage, loss or destruction of Alberta Government Telephones instruments and accessories while such instruments and accessories are in or upon the premises of the customer.

2. TELEPHONE NUMBERS

The customer shall have no right, ownership, or interest in the telephone facilities and number assigned to him, or any right to continuance of service through any particular office, and the telephone number or central office designation, or both, of the customer may be changed upon reasonable notice to the customer when necessary.

3. PAYMENT OF CHARGES

All charges for installations, moves and monthly rentals shall be paid in advance. Such payments shall entitle the customer to service with all customers connected to the same exchange. Regular toll rates shall be charged for all service to locations outside such exchange.

An excess mileage charge may be added if a customer is outside of the exchange base rate area.

4. VACATION ALLOWANCES

Should a customer wish to have his service temporarily disconnected, he may do so on advance application. An allowance of one-half of the rental per month will be made for a vacation period of not less than one month and not more than twelve months. The customer shall state in his application the vacation period and shall pay for this period in advance. He shall notify Alberta Government Telephones when he wishes service resumed.

This condition shall not apply to multi-party line service.

5. JOINT USER SERVICE

A joint user is a person who shares a customer's exchange service in accordance with Tariff provisions. The rates for this service, including a directory listing, are available upon request.

6. CONSTRUCTION

When it is necessary to install special equipment or to incur any unusual expense in order to meet special requests, an additional charge payable in advance may be made based upon the equipment installed or other unusual expenses incurred.

7. CUSTOMER TERMINATION OF SERVICE

Customers terminating service must notify Alberta Government Telephones in writing or call the business office. Failing this, the customer shall be liable for all charges up to the date the service is terminated.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE—(Cont'd)

8. DIRECTORY

Alberta Government Telephones distributes to its customers as a general rule, one free copy of the customers exchange directory for each main or extension set. Copies of this and other directories published by Alberta Government Telephones may be obtained upon payment of the regular purchase price from the Directory Department at Calgary or by arrangement with your local business office.

The customer must not use any binder, cover holder or other attachments, except as provided or approved by Alberta Government Telephones.

Alberta Government Telephones shall not be liable for damages arising from errors or omissions in its directory listings, information service or reference of calls to another telephone number, or arising from omission of a listing from the directory and/or information records at the request of the customer or of any person purporting to act on his behalf; provided however that in the case of listings for which a specific charge applies, its liability for error or omission shall be limited to making a refund or cancellation of the charge computed at the monthly rate charged for each such listing for the period during which the error or omission continues.

Directory contents are copyrighted and must not be reproduced without permission.

9. SERVICE AND EQUIPMENT

If Alberta Government Telephones does not have the equipment necessary to furnish the service requested, the receipt of an application for service and of an advance payment shall not bind Alberta Government Telephones to furnish such service, and if the service is not furnished all money paid therefor by the applicant shall be refunded by Alberta Government Telephones.

The agents and employees of Alberta Government Telephones shall have the right, at any reasonable hour to enter the premises on which telephone service is furnished or equipment is installed, for the purpose of installing, inspecting, repairing or removing its equipment and wiring and collecting receipts from public and semi-public telephones.

10. USE OF SERVICE

No payment may be exacted, directly or indirectly from any person by any party other than Alberta Government Telephones for the use of any of Alberta Government Telephone's services, except where otherwise stipulated in Alberta Government Telephone's Tariffs or by special agreement.

11. TERMINATION OF SERVICE BY ALBERTA GOVERNMENT TELEPHONES

In the event of the customer being indebted to Alberta Government Telephones for previous service at the same or any other location, or in the event of default on the part of the customer in making payment of any amount owing by him to Alberta Government Telephones for current service, under any of its Tariffs or in complying with these conditions or using the service or equipment in contravention thereof or in any

way that, in Alberta Government Telephone's opinion, constitutes abuse, or fraudulent use, or an attempt to locate a person or transmit or receive a message without the payment of a message toll charge, Alberta Government Telephones may, without notice, suspend any or all of the services which it furnishes to the customer, until such amount or indebtedness has been paid and all violations have ceased or been remedied. Such action by Alberta Government Telephones shall not affect the customer's liability for the payment of all amounts owing by him to Alberta Government Telephones.

12. LIMITATION OF ALBERTA GOVERNMENT TELEPHONES LIABILITY

Alberta Government Telephones shall not be liable for any defacement or damage to the customer's premises resulting from Alberta Government Telephone's equipment and wiring on such premises or from the installation, maintenance or removal thereof, except that Alberta Government Telephones shall make good any damage caused by its negligence. In cases where the customer is not the owner of such premises, he shall indemnify and save Alberta Government Telephones harmless from claims for such defacement or damage.

The customer shall indemnify and save Alberta Government Telephones harmless against and from all claims for libel, slander or infringement of copyright arising from the material transmitted over its equipment and/or recorded; against and from all claims for infringement of patents arising from combining or using apparatus or systems of the customer with the equipment of Alberta Government Telephones; and against from all other claims arising out of any act or omission of the customer in connection with equipment provided by Alberta Government Telephones.

13. PROHIBITIONS

No person shall:—

- (a) use profane, obscene or abusive language over telecommunication lines;
- (b) use a telephone for annoying, or interfering with the use of a telephone by a customer or any other person;
- (c) use telecommunication lines for any unlawful purpose;
- (d) use telecommunication lines to assist in the carrying out of any unlawful purpose;
- (e) record telephone conversations without using recorder connector equipment supplied and installed by Alberta Government Telephones, which equipment produces a distinctive tone repeated at intervals of approximately fifteen seconds to notify customers and others that the conversation is being recorded;
- (f) wire-tap or attach or use any un-authorized electrical or mechanical connection or apparatus to or with the lines or instruments installed by Alberta Government Telephones;
- (g) refuse to give up the use of a party line when requested to do so by the operator or any other person desiring to use the line in case of fire, accident, illness or other similar emergency.
