INTRODUCTION

Lean into the safety and security of God's Word, His truth, and His arms of love and compassion, where you will be comforted and encouraged.

Pray about your circumstances instead of worrying about them. Commit your problems to God in prayer, trusting that He will provide deliverance.

God's Word reminds us: *"Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths,"* (Proverbs 3:5-6).

God loves you. You never need to doubt His safety and protection. When your faith needs strengthening...when you need courage and peace...when you need wisdom to know what to do... draw on the Word of God to bless and encourage you. There you will find wisdom and strength that comforts, counsels, guides, directs, and teaches you.

As you read these devotions, invite the Holy Spirit to supernaturally impart God's peace into your mind, soul, and spirit. Allow these verses to soak into your very being.

You will find as the psalmist David said, "*Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path.*"

Jesus paid the price for our sins—He has given us a brand new life. All we have to do is take off the old self like a dirty shirt and simply put on the clean royal robes of our new life.

The Lord appeared to him from afar, saying, 'I have loved you with an everlasting love; therefore I have drawn you with lovingkindness.'

∞ JEREMIAH 31:3

But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved).
