

Secrets to Circle Piecing

(Throw Quilt)

- Cut A Round Ruler By Cheryl Phillips 6 to 17 inch
- 4 fat quarters to use for practice circles
- Fabric (use any light and dark combination-doesn't have to be black & white)
 - (4) - ½ yard Light fabrics for Background squares
 - (4) - ½ yard Dark fabrics for Background squares
 - (4) - ½ yard Light fabrics for Circles
 - (4) - ½ yard Dark fabrics for Circles
 - ½ yard Accent fabric (optional)
- Rotary Cutter 45mm (with fresh blade, please)
- Cutting Matt
- Pins, thread, ruler (large enough to cut 13 inch squares)
- Sewing Machine and general quilting supplies

Please precut a few background fabrics into 13 inch squares

This quilt can be easily made bigger or smaller by adding or taking away the number of Circles.
