

Treasures of the Deep – 3 part workshop

Supplies list

- Cotton Fabric ¼ yard pieces: 4-6 pieces in blue, teal, turquoise, green, purple, and other ocean colors plus 2-4 pieces in tan, brown, grey, beige colors for the ocean floor.
 - These can all be scraps or Fat Quarters but need to be large enough to cut in a curve with a rotary cutter.
- Sheer Fabric: 3-5 pieces (quarter or eighth yard cuts are plenty) of sheer fabrics such as tulle, organza, crinkle organza, sheer lame', etc. in ocean colors, greens, corals, etc. plus a 1 yard piece of teal, blue or green tulle
- ⅔ yd Cotton batting and backing fabric
- Threads - we will be using several types of threads for this project:
 - Decorative embroidery thread and quilting threads in colors that compliment, contrast, match, etc. with your fabrics. *these can include decorative, variegated decorative, metallic, thicker threads (must go thru the needle), variegated cotton quilting, etc.
 - Neutral cotton thread for bobbin (neutral to your thread pallet)
 - thread to match your backing fabric
 - Polyester monofilament thread in smoke or clear.
- Machine Needles- Embroidery 75/11, Topstitching 90/14 and 100/16, quilting needles in favorite size. (these can be purchased during class from the store if you don't have what you need)
- Quilt sandwich for practicing stitches and testing tensions – several smaller pieces approx. 10" x 10"
- 2-3 yards lightweight fusible web
- water soluble stabilizer - ½ yd
- Decorative yarns you may wish to use in addition to the yarns in the kit*
- Beads – seed beads, bugles, focus beads, etc.*
- Rotary cutter and rulers.
- Basic sewing and quilting supplies (free motion foot, snips, pins, **extra bobbins**, etc.)
- Your sewing machine, in good working order, **and the manual**

*I will bring some of these supplies for purchase during class

**Remember - Your kit fee of \$20.00 includes: Hand outs, Angelina fibers, 2 types Cheesecloth, three types of Textile Paint, Decorative yarn and some beads and embellishments to get you started, cording for binding, and a few accent sheer fabrics.

Feel free to bring additional supplies for embellishing during the second class, we can discuss ways you might use them so long as time allows.
