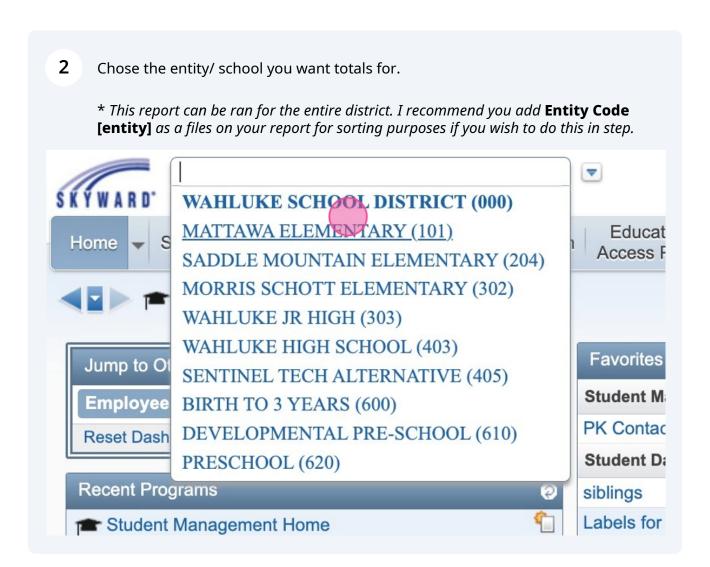
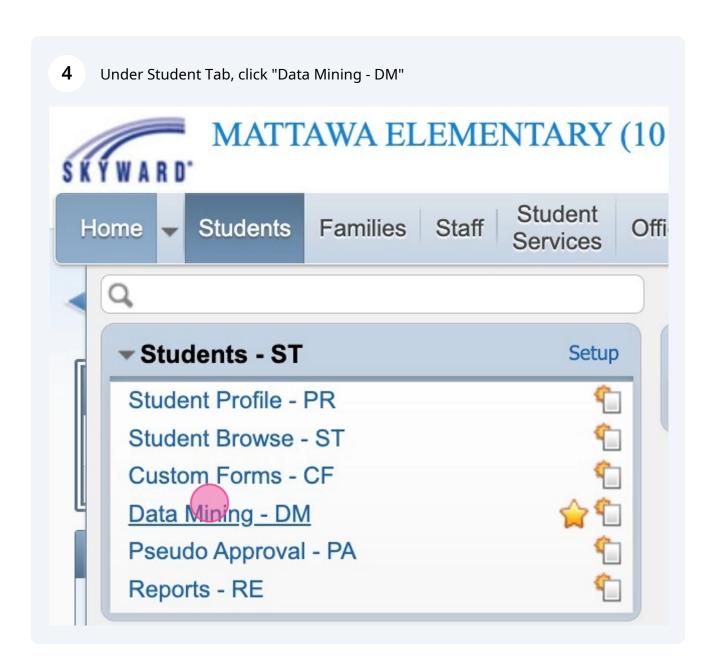
Skyward (SMS2) Data Mining: Migrant Student Attendance for Mass Withdrawal Processing in MSIS2 (Using Excel)

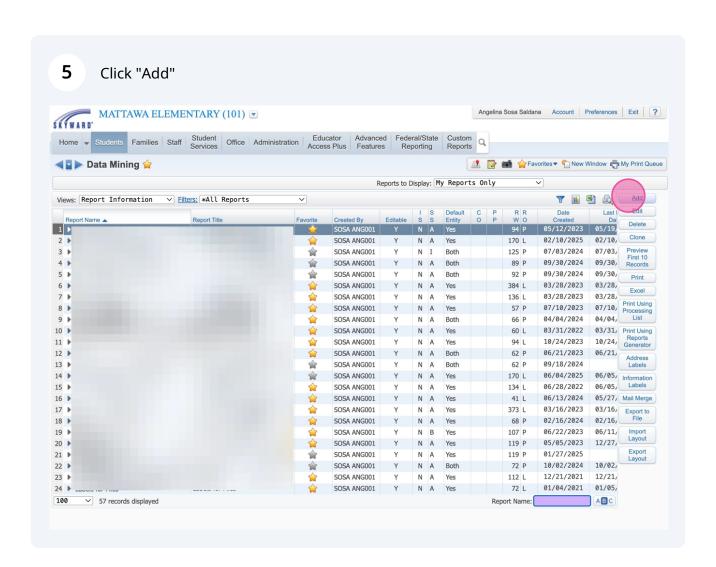
This guide walks you through the process of generating a data mining report from Skyward to support mass migrant student withdrawals in MSIS2. The report is exported to Excel, where you can use formulas (such as subtraction) to calculate total days present. These totals are required to complete accurate mass withdrawals in MSIS2.



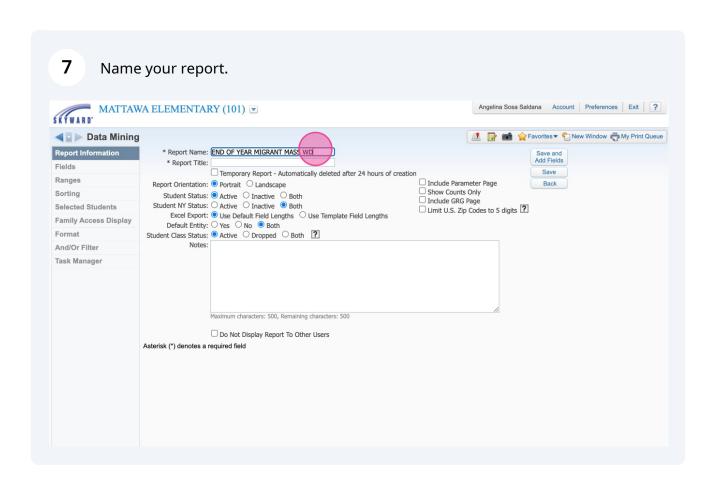


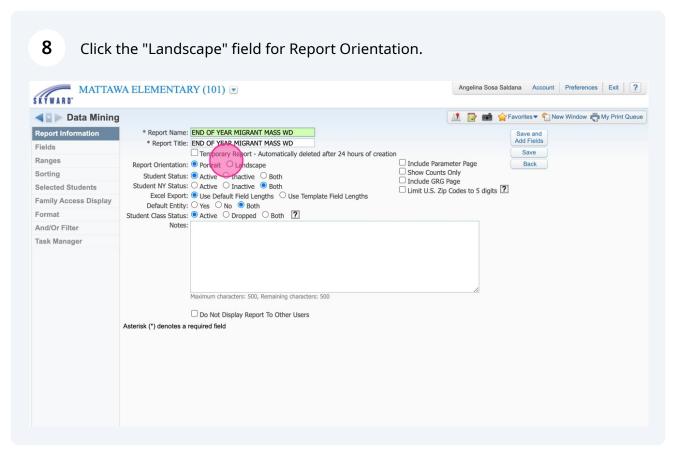


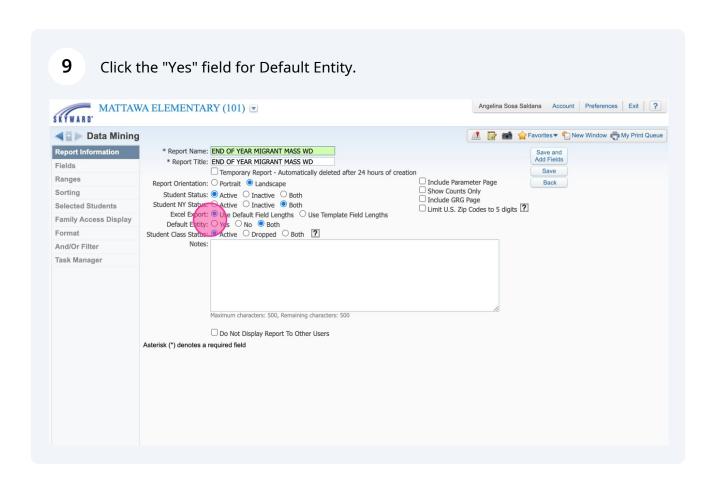


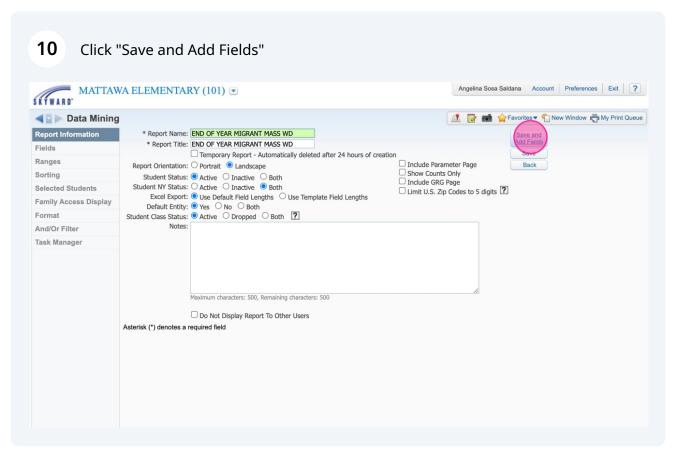


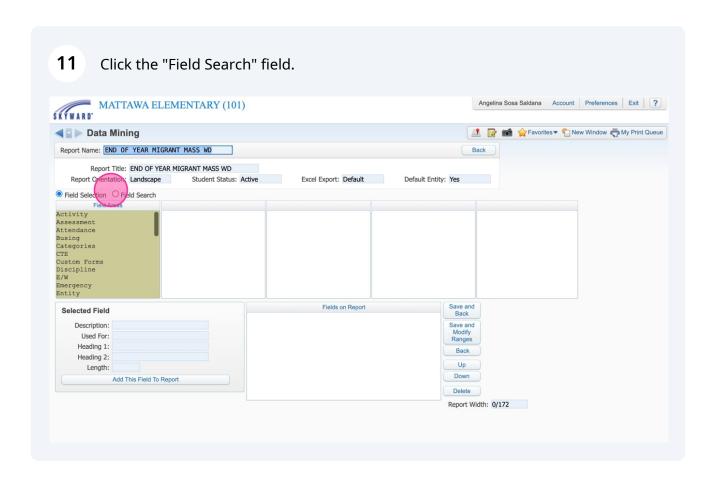

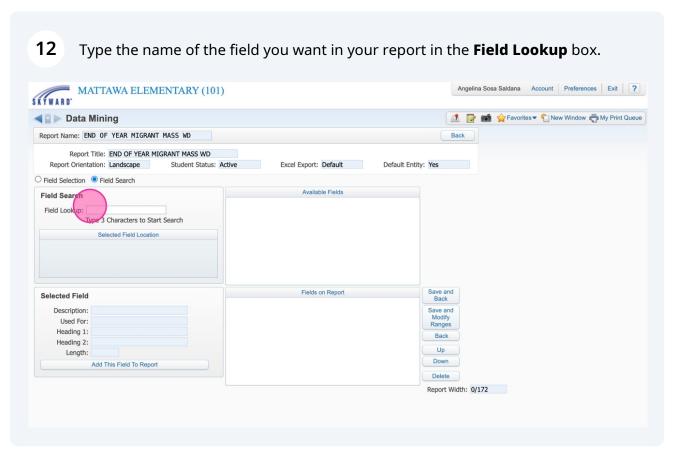




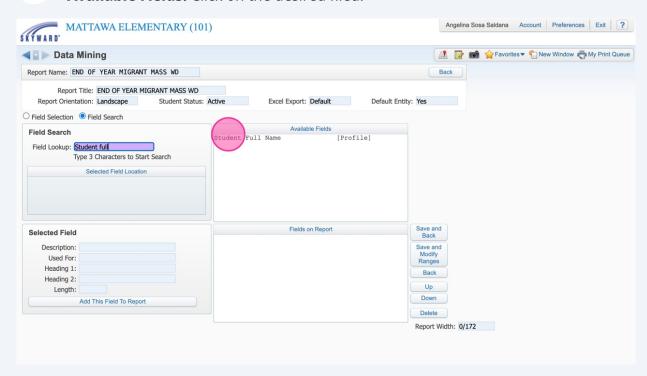






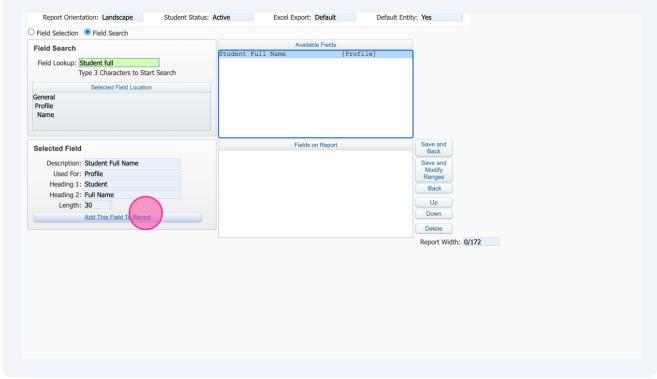


As you type the field name, matching fields will populate in the right box under **Available Fields.** Click on the desired filed.



The selected filed's info will appear in the **Selected Field** section. If correct click "Add This Field To Report".

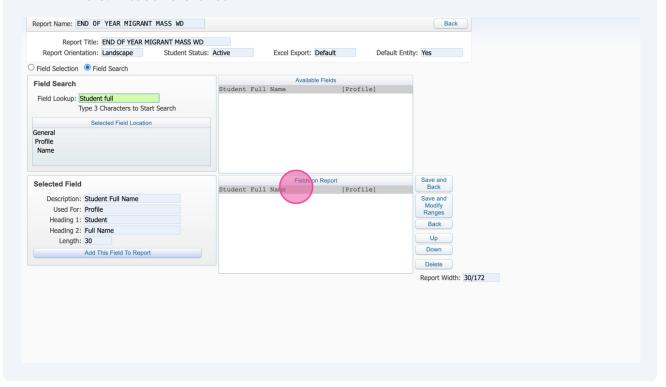

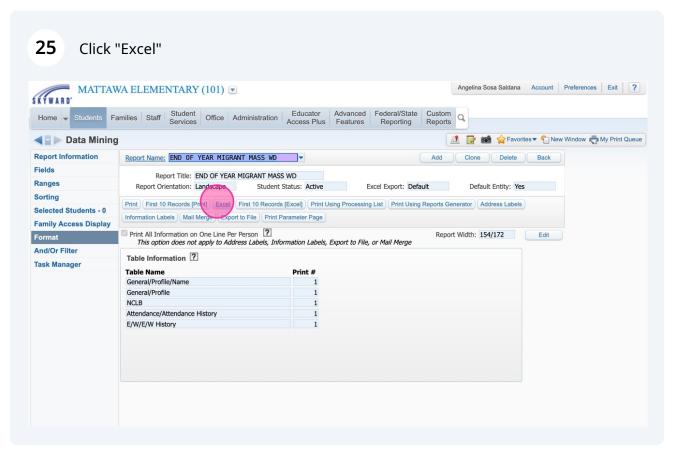


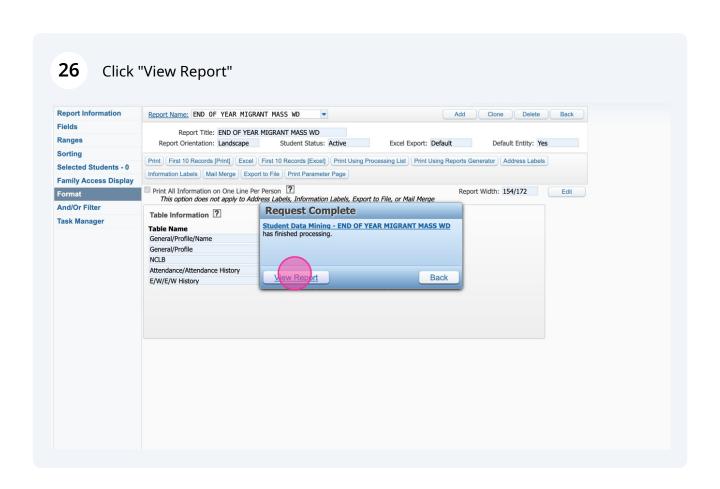




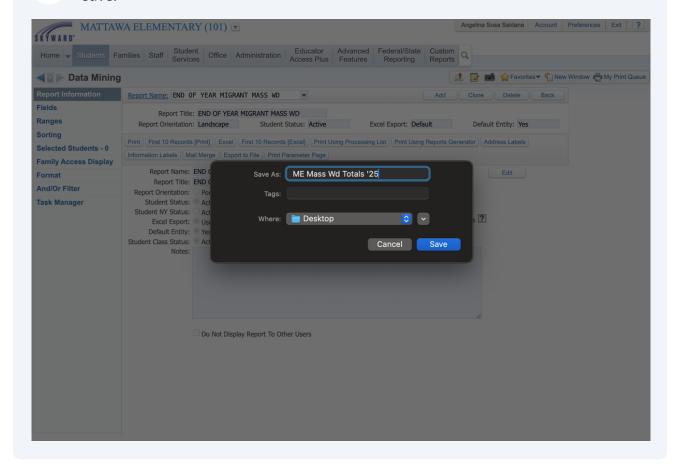




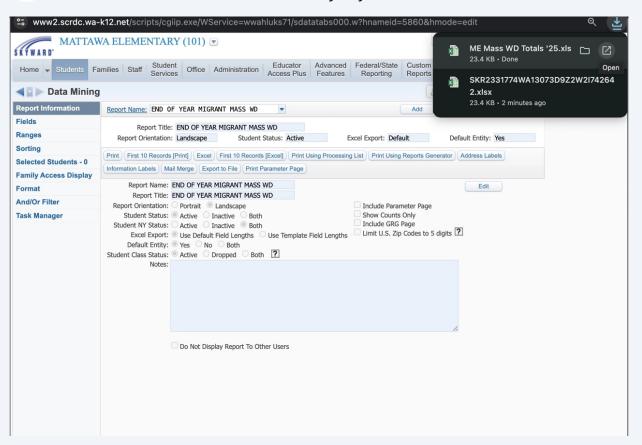




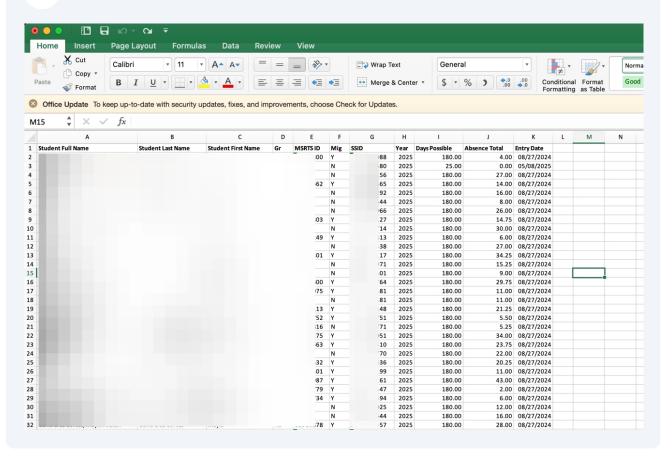
When you click View Report, it will prompt you to name the file. Name and click save.



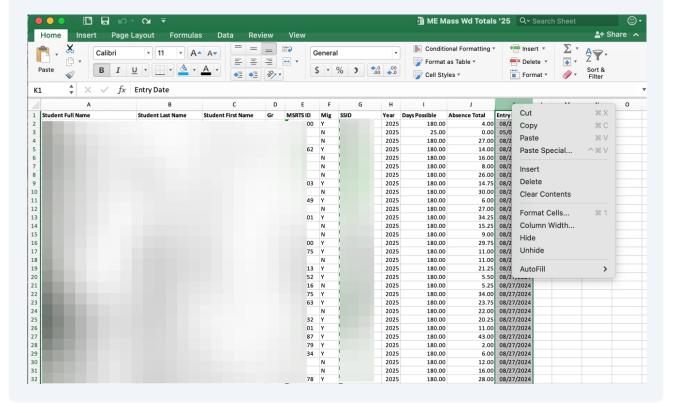
Open or Locate the Exported Excel File Your file should download automatically to your download folder.



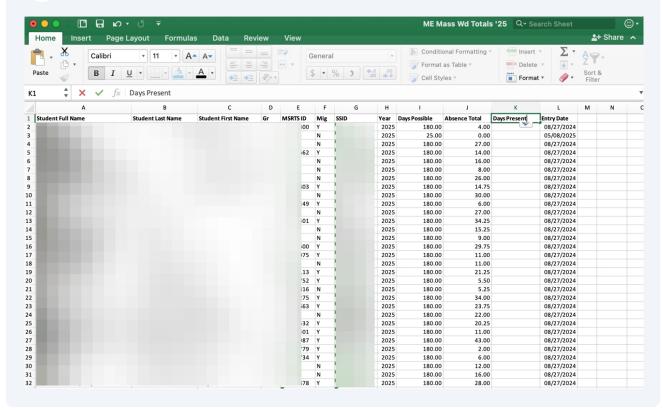
29 Open the excel sheet.



Right-click on the column header after the Absence Total column. In this example, right-click on column "J". Select **Insert** from the context menu.



Select the fist cell under the newly added column and type **Days Present** as the header.



32 In the cell right under the Days Present header (cell K2) enter the excel formula:

=I2-J2

This a subtraction formula. It's used to subtract the value in cell J2 from the value in cell I2. This formula will produce the total days present for the student in that row.

Steps **32 - 35** will guide you on how to do that step by step.

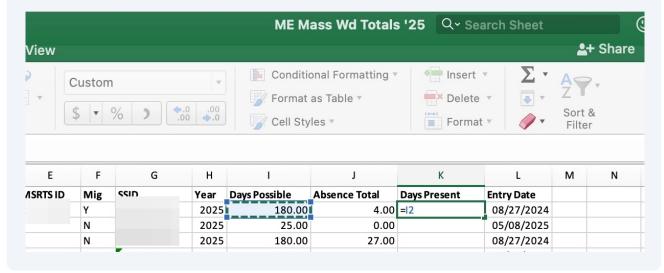

Using your plus sign cursor, click on the first cell under Days Possible. It will turn blue with a dashed border, and the cell name will appear next to the "=" sign in the cell where the formula is being entered.

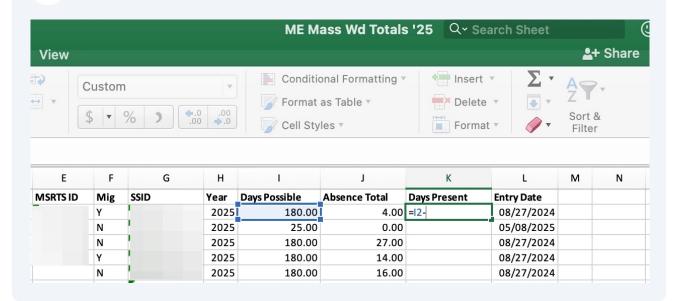

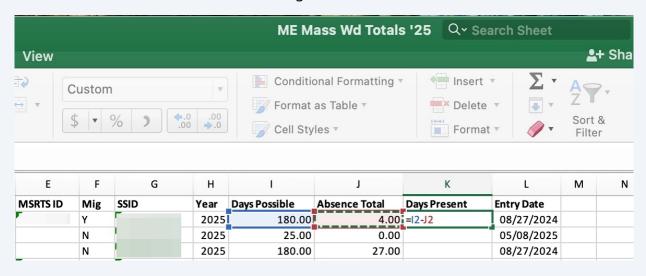

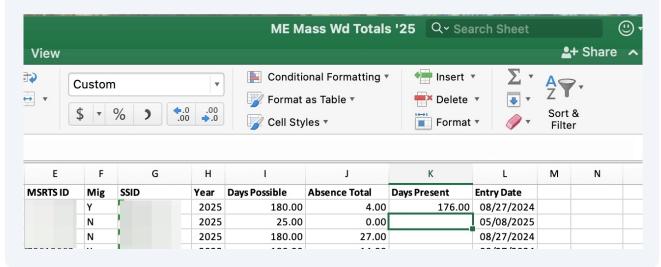
35 Enter the minus sign by clicking the "-" key on your keyboard.



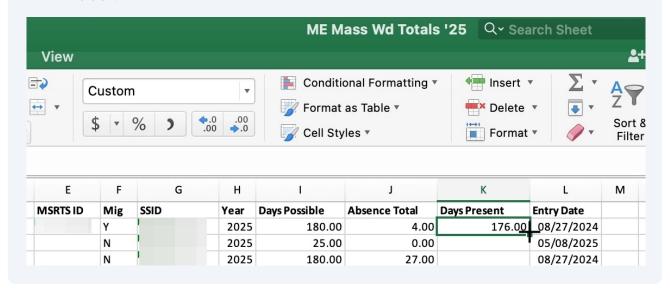
Using your plus sign cursor again, click on the first cell under Absence Total. It will turn red with a dashed border, and the cell name will appear next to the "-" sign in the cell where the formula is being entered.



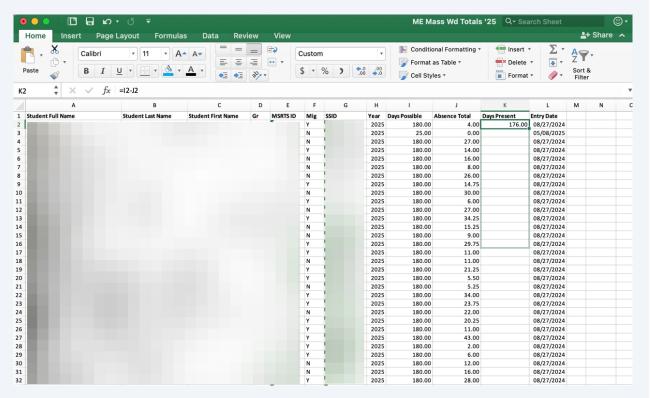
Click the Enter key on your keyboard. The formula will do the math and the total days present will show in the cell.



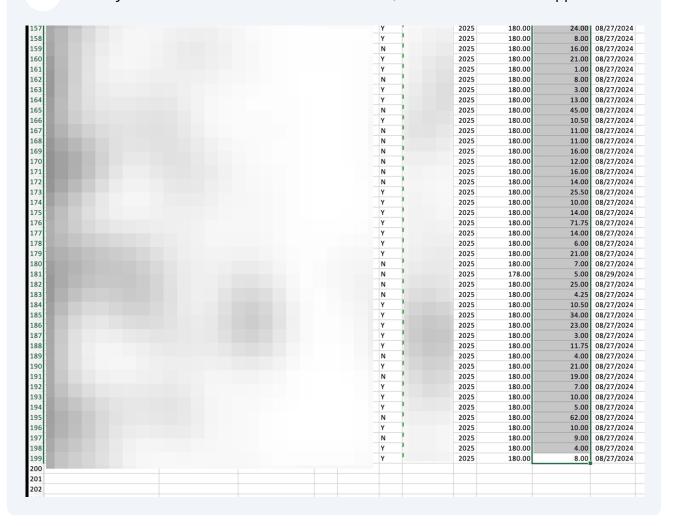
Using your plus sign cursor again, hover over the small green square in the corner of the first cell under Absence Total where total is shown. The cursor will turn black.



Once the cursor turns black click down, hold, and drag down to select all the cell where total days present are needed.



40 Once you reach the bottom release the cursor, all totals should now appear.



You've successfully exported the report and your data is now ready in Excel! You can sort, filter, and move data as needed. This final data set will support accurate mass withdrawals in MSIS2.
