

PASS PORTABLE ASSISTED STUDY SEQUENCE PROGRAM



WHAT IS PASS? Portable Assisted Study Sequence Program—PASS is a credit accrual program offered in approximately 30 states throughout the U.S. Washington State is the 2nd largest state offering the PASS program.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO ENROLL IN PASS? Migrant students may qualify for PASS if they are in grades 7-12, are enrolled full- or part-time at a school building AND are unable to satisfy a credit and/or graduation requirement in a regular or summer school classroom setting.

WHAT STUDENTS MAY CONSIDER PASS?

Student(s) who:

- Are highly mobile student(s)
- Need to satisfy credit or graduation requirement(s) (e.g. Washington State History) and who have:
 - class scheduling conflicts
 - competing work, family, or extra-curricular responsibilities
- Are homebound and want/need to study at home
- Are unable to complete course in regular classroom setting and who may benefit from a focused environment with individual support

WHY CHOOSE PASS?

1. COST EFFECTIVE:

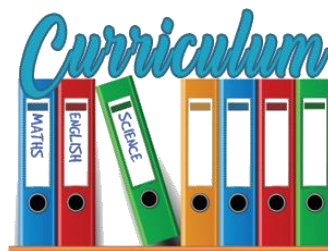
- District retains student FTE
- No cost to the migrant student or family

2. FLEXIBLE:

- Flexible program design options to meet the district and student needs
- Contacts may be certificated or classified
- Portability for highly mobile students; computer and internet access not required
- Online test options and immediate results for most courses

3. TRAINING AND RESOURCES PROVIDED:

- MSDRS offers flexible PASS contact training options
- Counselor and contact placement resources
- Online program and student monitoring tools and email notifications

COURSE GUIDES: Available for each course

COURSE COST: FREE FOR ELIGIBLE MIGRANT STUDENTS

- Non-migrant funded districts receive required supplemental course materials.
- Migrant funded districts may use funds from the grant to purchase required supplemental materials.

COURSE/CREDIT: Unless otherwise noted, courses are equivalent to a semester .5 credits / Carnegie units.

- Course Placement: Full or partial credit enrollment options available.

TRANSCRIPTS: Fully accredited, transcripts issued by Sunnyside School District and mailed to school registrar upon completion

DIFFERENTIATED INSTRUCTION: Text and online resources to support differentiated instruction.

TESTING: Most online tests are scored by PASS, with some assignments submitted to certificated scorers to score and provide feedback.
