ORDINANCE NO. 021-040
DATE OF PASSAGE August 10, 2021

An Ordinance amending Chapter 6, Sec. 6-2 of the Aurora Liquor Control Ordinance pertaining to Complimentary Beer or Wine Service.

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has a population of more than 25,000 persons and is, therefore, a home rule unit under subsection (a) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, subject to said Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is appropriate and in the best interest of the City to amend Sec. 6-2 of the Aurora Liquor Control Ordinance to modify the definition of Complimentary Beer or Wine Service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Aurora, Illinois, as follows:

Section One: That the Aurora Liquor Control Ordinance shall be and hereby is amended as set forth in said "Exhibit A."

Section Two: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect, and shall be controlling, upon its passage and approval.

Section Three: That all Ordinances or part of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as any conflict exists.

Section Four: That any section, phrase or paragraph of this Ordinance that is construed to be invalid, void or unconstitutional shall not affect the remaining sections, phrases, or paragraphs of this Ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect.

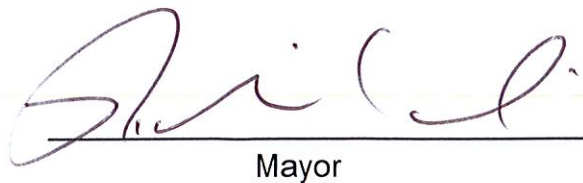

1 **Sec 6-2 Definitions**

3 ~~Complementary Complimentary Beer or Wine~~ Alcohol Service authorizes a business engaged in providing

4 non-food or non-alcoholic goods or services to the public to allow the consumption of ~~beer and wine~~

5 alcohol containing less than 15% ABV by its patrons who are twenty-one (21) and over that ~~(1) is~~

6 ~~brought to the premises of the business by the patron (BYOB) and/or (2) is provided at no cost~~ served by

7 the business ~~as a complement to~~ in conjunction with the patron's purchase of goods or services offered

8 by the business. ~~(complementary service)~~. The licensee may provide patrons of the business with

9 individual servings of ~~wine or beer~~ alcohol in glasses at no charge ~~or may provide glasses and ice for~~

10 ~~patrons who bring their own beer or wine to the premises~~. No ~~wine or beer~~ alcohol may be served to or

11 consumed by persons on the business premises except ~~as a complement to~~ in conjunction with the

12 patron's contemporaneous purchase or consumption of goods and services made available to the public

13 by the licensee. A licensee under this section is prohibited from having a "bar" or "taps" for service of

14 beer or wine alcohol. The ~~complementary complimentary~~ service or consumption of ~~beer or wine~~

15 alcohol at the licensed premises is limited to not more than two (2) ~~three (3)~~ servings of alcohol ~~beer or~~

16 wine ~~alcoholic beverages~~ by a patron during any single calendar day. ~~regardless of whether the~~

17 ~~beverage is provided by the licensee or brought to the licensed premises by the patron~~. No alcoholic

18 ~~beverages other than beer or wine are permitted~~. It shall be unlawful for the licensee, its agents, and

19 employees to permit any patron to leave the licensed premises with an open container of alcohol ~~wine~~

20 ~~or beer~~ ~~regardless of whether the container is provided by the licensee or brought to the licensed~~

21 ~~premises by the patron~~. A Basset trained employee of the licensee must be present at all times that

22 alcohol is consumed on the premises. Video gaming on premises is not permitted.
