ORDINANCE NO. 022-Dale
DATE OF PASSAGE April 26, 2022

An Ordinance amending Chapter 6 Sec. 6-2 and 6-28 of the Code of Ordinances pertaining to hours of service.

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has a population of more than 25,000 persons and is, therefore, a home rule unit under subsection (a) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, subject to said Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of its home rule powers, it is necessary and desirable to amend the code regarding the licensing of businesses to sell alcohol.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Aurora, Illinois, as follows:

Section One: That Chapter 6 Sec. 6-2 and 6-28 shall be and hereby are amended as set forth in Exhibit A.

Section Two: That the ordinances shall be in full force and effect, and shall be controlling, upon the passage and approval of the ordinances.

Section Three: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.

Section Four: That any section or provision of these ordinances that are construed to be invalid or void shall not affect the remaining sections or provisions which shall remain in full force and effect thereafter.

Section Five: That the City Clerk and Corporation Counsel are hereby authorized to make any non-substantive or clerical changes to Chapter 6, Sec. 6-2 and 6-28 as necessary for purposes of updating the online municipal code.

1 **Sec 6-2 Definitions**

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3 Breakfast and Lunch Service Only Endorsement authorizes the sale, on the premises specified on the
4 license, of alcoholic liquors for consumption on the premises at a restaurant that provides only full
5 service breakfast/brunch/lunch service, as distinguished from restaurants that serve, or also serve,
6 dinner. Authorizes qualifying full-service restaurants to sell alcohol in conjunction with the purchase and
7 consumption of a meal on Sundays between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. To be eligible for
8 video gaming, establishments must meet all requirements of Chapter 8, Article IV, Division 5 entitled
9 "Video Gaming".

12 **Sec 6-28 Hours Of Operation**

13 (a) *On-Site Consumption.* Businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor for consumption on the
14 licensed premises may sell or permit to be sold for consumption on the licensed premises,
15 alcoholic liquor only between the following hours, unless otherwise provided:

- 17 (1) Monday through Thursday from 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. the following morning;
18 (2) Friday and Saturday from 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. the following morning;
19 (3) Sunday from 9:00 a.m. (with the service of food) to 1:00 a.m. the following morning;
20 (4) Thanksgiving Eve from 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. on Thanksgiving morning; and
21 (5) New Year's Eve from 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. on New Year's Day morning.
22 (6) Businesses holding a Breakfast and Lunch Service Only Endorsement may serve alcohol
23 on Sundays from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
