ORDINANCE NO. 024-071
DATE OF PASSAGE November 26, 2024

An Ordinance amending Chapter 29 of the City of Aurora Code of Ordinances.

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has a population of more than 25,000 persons and is, therefore, a home rule unit under subsection (a) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, subject to said Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, there are reports of serious incidents in massage parlors and similar business in Aurora that the Aurora Police Department has been investigating and addressing that require more expeditious enforcement; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of public health, safety and welfare of the City of Aurora residents to expand the activities that currently are defined as aggravate nuisances activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Aurora, Illinois, as follows:

Section One: That Section 29-126 of Chapter 29 of the Code of Ordinances shall be and hereby is amended as set forth in Exhibit A.

Section Two: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect, and shall be controlling, upon passage and approval;

Section Three: That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar any conflict exist.
