ORDINANCE NO. 025-032
DATE OF PASSAGE MAY 13, 2025

An Ordinance correcting and replacing O25-028 Chapter 27, Section 27-176 "Parking Commercial Vehicles, Trailers, Truck Trailers and Truck Tractors in Residential Districts.

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has a population of more than 25,000 persons and is, therefore, a home rule unit under subsection (a) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, subject to said Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, amendments to Chapter 27, Section 27-176 "Parking Commercial Vehicles, Trailers, Truck Trailers and Truck Tractors in Residential Districts were adopted on April 22, 2025, as Ordinance O25-028; and

WHEREAS, the amendments adopted in the ordinance did not contain all strikethroughs of the prior language required to achieve the articulated intent of the proposed changes; and

WHEREAS, there was an additional error in the ordinance requiring correction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Aurora, Illinois, as follows: amendments to Chapter 27, Section 27-176 of the Code of Ordinances shall be adopted as set forth in Exhibit A-Chapter 27-176 CORRECTED, attached hereto, and Ordinance O25-028 is superseded by this Ordinance.

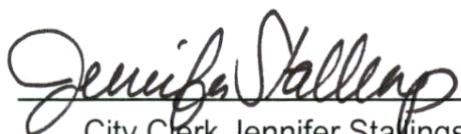

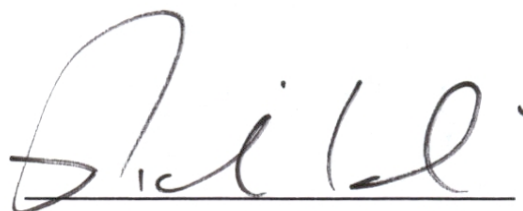

1 **"Sec 27-176 Parking Commercial Vehicles, Trailers, Truck Tractors**

2
3 No commercial vehicle, or truck tractor, with or without a trailer,
4 shall be permitted to park on any public street in the city if the
5 vehicle exceeds~~ing~~ 8,000 lbs., according to vehicle registration,
6 gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR), or loaded weight, ~~two (2) tons~~
7 ~~in weight, according to vehicle registration, or any type of~~
8 ~~trailer, regardless if the trailer or semi-trailer is attached to~~
9 ~~another vehicle shall be permitted to park on any public street in~~
10 ~~a residential district:~~

11
12 (a) Between the hours of 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.; or

13 (b) For a period longer than two hours between the hours of
14 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.; or

15 (c) In a manner to obstruct other vehicular traffic or cause
16 a hazard.

18 The parking restrictions of this section shall also apply to any
19 type of trailer, regardless of whether the trailer or semi-trailer
20 is attached to another vehicle. For the purposes of this section,
21 trailer is defined as: Every vehicle without motive power in
22 operation, designed for carrying persons or property and for being
23 drawn by a motor vehicle including but not limited to watercraft
24 trailers, utility trailers, travel trailers, truck campers,

1 camping trailers, landscape trailers, and vehicle transport
2 trailers.

4 For the purposes of this section, commercial vehicles actively
5 being used to make a delivery or render a service to a nearby
6 business or residence shall not be subject to the parking
7 restrictions contained herein, except that such vehicles shall not
8 park in a manner to obstruct other vehicular traffic or cause a
9 hazard, as determined by a police officer or other person
10 authorized by the chief of police.

11
12 Vehicles in violation of this section shall be subject to immediate
13 towing by order of the police department, and fines as provided by
14 section 1-10 of this Code.
