



CITY OF AURORA, ILLINOIS

ORDINANCE NO. 025-097
DATE OF PASSAGE December 16, 2025

An Ordinance amending Section 5-56 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Aurora to increase the fuel flowage fee from \$0.05 to \$0.06 per gallon of fuel sold at the Aurora Municipal Airport.

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has a population of more than 25,000 persons and is, therefore, a home rule unit under subsection (a) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, subject to said Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora owns, operates and maintains the Aurora Municipal Airport; and

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 1990, each operator authorized to sell aviation fuel at the Aurora Municipal Airport was to pay a charge of five cents (\$0.05) to the City for each gallon of fuel sold; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora desires to increase the fuel flowage fee to six cents (\$0.06) per gallon in accordance with the provisions of the fixed-based operators' lease.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Aurora, Illinois, as follows: that Section 5-56 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Aurora shall be and hereby is amended to increase the fuel flowage fee to six cents (\$0.06) per gallon.

BE IT ORDAINED, that said amendment shall be immediately effective.

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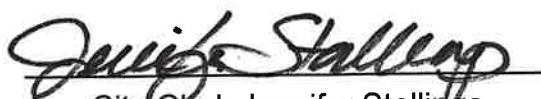

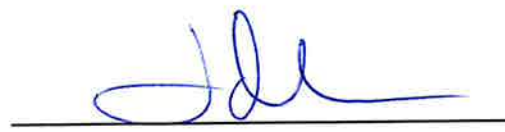
