

**ORDINANCE NO. 2004 - 06**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 17, OF THE CITY OF BYRON'S MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 17.48.010 RELATING TO ZONING BOARD TERMS**

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Municipal Code permits the City of Byron to regulate zoning within its City boundaries;

**WHEREAS**, due to resignations from members of the Zoning Board of Appeals, the current Zoning Board of Appeals has six members whose terms are due to expire at the same time;

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the City Council and the Zoning Board of Appeals to pass staggered terms;

**WHEREAS**, the seventh member of the Zoning Board of Appeals, Joe Farris, has a term that will expire April 30, 2005. Nothing in this Ordinance shall affect Joe Farris' rights and obligations to fulfill that term, except that his successor, if any, shall serve a three year term as provided by this Ordinance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BYRON, OGLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS**, as follows:


Section 1: Title 17, Zoning, Chapter 17.48, Administration and Enforcement, shall be amended by replacing, in its entirety, Section 17.48.010 Board of Appeals-Creation-Appointment, as follows:

17.48.010 Board of Appeals-Creation-Appointment. A Board of Appeals is created. The Board shall consist of seven members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council to serve the following terms: two for one year, two for two years, two for 3 years, with the remaining current member's term expiring April 30, 2005. The successor to each member so appointed shall serve a term of three years. One of the members shall be named as Chairman by the Mayor, at the time of his/her appointment. The Board shall appoint a secretary from its membership and shall prescribe rules for the conduct of its affairs. Said rules shall be approved by the City Council. The Board shall meet on the second and fourth Thursdays of each month; provided that there is business to be addressed by the Board.

Section 2: All Ordinances or parts thereof or Resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
